adulteration

Bangladesh Standard and Testing Institution (BSTI) is set to kick off a special drive across the country to check the sales of adulterated food and other commodities that caused seri-

ous public health concern. The decision was taken at a meeting at the industries ministry Monday, chaired by Mahbub Jamil, special assis-

tant to the chief adviser. "The sellers of adulterated commodities will be fined and punished in an effort to restrain them from committing such acts," the government said in an announcement.

Activities of the antiadulteration drive will be widely publicised in the media as part of a massive publicawareness campaign.

The government step came in the wake of news reports that the market is awash with adulterated goods because of a mindless marketing strategy by a section of businesspeople.

\$540m ejected from Pak market in only 3 months

Foreign investors have ejected US\$540 million from the Pakistani stock market in only three months from July to September amid prolonged political uncertainty, burgeoning insecurity in the tribal belt of the country coupled with global and local economic slowdown.

So far this month, foreign investors have withdrawn \$96 million, reflecting an increase of US\$68 million versus US\$28 million outflow witnessed in a month earlier.
