

He will call on President Iajuddin Ahmed at Bangabhaban on October 8.

Maung Aye's itinerary includes visit to National Mausoleum at Savar, Military Institute of Science and Technology (MIST) at Mirpur and a tour of Rangamati from where he will leave for Myanmar on

His visit is taking place after Bangladesh and Myanmar signed an agreement in Dhaka in July 2007 to establish a 25-kilometer direct road link between the two neighbours to boost trade and tourism.

The US\$20 million "Friendship Road" from Gundhum in Cox's Bazar to Baulibazar in Myanmar was also designed to connect China's Kunming under tri-nation road connectivity which will give further access to Thailand, Malaysia and Singapore and to the Asian Highway.

Bangladesh and Myanmar have maintained exchange of high-level visits in recent years. In December 2002, Myanmar SPDC Chairman Senior General Than Shwe visited Dhaka, while in 2003, Prime Minister Khaleda Zia went to Yangon, during which the two countries signed two memorandums of understanding (MoUs) on the establishment of a joint trade commission and an agreement on coastal and maritime shipping.
