The Rabindra Memorial Museum at Shahjadpur in Sirajganj district houses some rare photographs of Nobel laureate poet Rabindranath Tagore and his family. Unfortunately these priceless items are wasting away because of poor maintenance and neglect.

Nahid Sultana, custodian, protected archaeological site Rabindra Memorial Museum pointed out that only 57 reproductions of paintings by poet are on display at the museum. On Officials of the department the other hand, 87 rare photographs of Tagore and his family members along with other prominent personalities of the day have been preserved at the museum.
