The media should address the genuine needs of the indigenous people in a proper way through detailed and objective reports, speakers said at a roundtable at Kamalganj in Moulvibazar yester-

there are so many issues concerning the ethnic people's rights and the media hardly highlight them. They suggested that the media should focus on the indigenous people's rights rather than portraying just their livelihood and cul-

Shahana Huda, manager (Media and Communication) of Manusher Jonno Foundation, moderated the roundtable attended by 24 community/NGO representatives and local journalists.






