

5 motor vehicles recovered, 5 held

Members of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) recovered five motor vehicles, including trucks, microbuses and private car and arrested five people from different parts of the country yesterday.

The arrestees are Md Omar Faruq, Chatkhali JCD President Kazi Mustakimur Rahman Asif, Amir Hossen alias Shohug of the same district, Kamal Hossen of Krishnapur village of the same district and Manik alias Usif of Narpura village at Manohar upazila in Comilla.

Acting on a tip-off, a Rab-2 team nabbed gang leader Faruq from Japan Garden City in the city's Adabora area.

According to his statement, several teams of Rab conducted drives at Adabora, Jaintia in Sylhet, Kotwali upazila in Comilla and Ramgarh in Lakshmipur and recovered two trucks, two microbuses, one private car, fake registration numbers of cars and sedative tablets and arrested them.

Quoting Faruq, Rab officials said the criminals used to hire cars and other motor vehicles from different cities and towns, including Dhaka, Chittagong and Sylhet, and snatched those making drivers of the cars senseless with sedatives when they reached their target areas.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Metropolitan Police recovered seven motorbikes and arrested two in this connection

yesterday.

The arrestees were identified as Shuman, 28, of Lalbagh area and Borhan, 45, of Rayer Bazar area.

Police said according to their confessional statements, they seized a white private car from Kalabagan area, which was used in snatching motorbikes and other valuables.

SC again asks govt to provide magistrates with all facilities

The Supreme Court (SC) yesterday again directed the government to provide judicial magistrates with all necessary support staff, vehicles and other requirements.

The full bench of the Appellate Division headed by Chief Justice MM Ruhul Amin also asked the government to submit to this court a report regarding arrangement of manpower, transport and other support for judicial magistrates by November 27.

The apex court passed the order during the hearing of the Masder Hossain case, popularly known as judiciary separation case.

Moeen seeks Korean help in developing defence capability

Army Chief General Moeen U Ahmed yesterday met Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff of Korean Armed Forces General Kim Tae-Young and sought Korean government's cooperation in developing in Korea.

During the meeting, General Moeen also proposed that Korean companies could set up joint venture companies in Bangladesh to produce armaments and vehicles, and requested for increased training opportunities for the officers of Bangladesh Army to receive training in Korea.

General Kim assured him of best possible cooperation from his side in this regard and appreciated the role of Bangladesh army in UN peacekeeping operations.

Earlier in an interview to the "The Korea Times", a widely circulated English newspaper, General Moeen highlighted the significant role of Bangladesh Armed Forces in maintaining international peace through participation in the UN peacekeeping operations around the world. He also said Bangladesh has many things to learn from the miraculous economic development of Korea.

Later, General Moeen attended a dinner hosted in his honour by Bangladesh Ambassador to South Korea Shahidul Islam.
