# RU 'controversial' staffs lay siege to VC office

Some 200 'controversially appointed' fourth-class employees of Rajshahi University (RU) yesterday kept Acting Vice Chancellor Prof Mamnunul Keramat confined to his office for one hour to press home their demand for regularisation of their jobs.

The agitating employees laid siege to the VC's office and staged a sit-in in front of the office.

During the demonstration, they also demanded resignation of Prof. Mamnunul Keramat for his failure to confirm their jobs by the deadline they gave earlier.

The employees also urged the chief adviser and the University Grants Commission (UGC) chairman to take necessary steps for confirmation of their jobs.

They threatened not to cooperate in the upcoming admission test if their demand goes unheeded.

Later, a seven-member team of the employees held talks with the RU authorities at the VC's office.

RU Treasurer Prof Dr Mozammel Haque, Registrar Prof Mohammad Shafi, Proctor Enamu Haque, Student Adviser Faridul Islam Pintu and high-ups of the law enforcement agencies were pres-

ent at the meeting. Sources said the acting VC assured the agitating employees that he would meet UGC chairman today and request him to take necessary steps to regularise

their jobs.

Following the assurance, the employees withdrew their sit-in demonstration at around 3:00pm. Earlier, they took out a protest

procession on the campus and paraded different streets. A large number of police were deployed on the campus to avert

any untoward incident. When contacted, Prot Mamnunul Keramat said, "We will talk with the higher authorities
