

Admission into MBBS course for the session 2008-2009

Applications are invited in prescribed form for admission into the first year MBBS course for the session 2008-2009 under following terms and conditions:

1. The applicant should be a Bangladeshi citizen. 2. (a) The students who passed SSC/Dakhil/O-level/10th grade/or equivalent examinations before the year 2005 are not eligible for application;

(b) Those who passed HSC/Alim/ A-level/12th grade/or equivalent examinations in the years 2007 and 2008 are only eligible for application.

3. Educational eligibilities for application are as follows:

The applicant's total GPA in SSC and HSC examinations should be 8.00 at the minimum. But under no circumstances GPA below 3.50 in any of the SSC, HSC or equivalent examinations will be accepted, and minimum GPA in Biology in HSC examination should be 3.00.

4. (a) Admission test will be on total of 200 marks: 100 marks for the results of SSC and HSC examina tions, SSC=40 and HSC=60 [8 (eight) times of GPA of SSC and 12 (twelve) times of GPA of HSC examinations).

(b) 100 marks will be allotted for a written (MCQ) examination. Questions on Physics, Chemistry, Biology, English and General Knowledge will be included in the examination. 0.25 marks will be deducted for each wrong answer.

Students studying under foreign curriculum who have passed the equivalent of SSC & HSC examinations should have their mark sheets converted into GPA.

(a) For 'O' Level or SSC equivalent examination- The highest marks obtained in five subjects will be considered and for additional or optional subject the marks obtained above GPA 2.00 will be added. (b) For 'A' Level three subjects (Biology, Chemistry and Physics) will be considered.

Candidate will have to submit the equivalence certificate from the Health Directorate after payment of requisite fees. 6. Foreign students should have similar or equivalent educational eligibility and they should fulfill all other

government requirements. Those who wish to apply under 'meritorious and poor' quota should have a minimum GPA of 5.00 in both SSC and HSC examinations in all subjects. Documents supporting the student's financial condition should be submitted with the application. Decision on the student's eligibility for inclusion in this quota

will lie at the discretion of the college authority. Separate forms should be collected to apply under general, Bangladesh Red Crescent Society, 'meritorious and poor' and foreign quotas. Application in more than one quota will not be accepted and one cannot change the quota under any circumstances once the application is submitted.

9. Application form and the prospectus may be collected from the college office during the office hours (from 8.00 AM to 1:30 PM) on payment of Taka 1,500.00 (one thousand five hundred) only (non-refundable) from 11th November 2008 to 30th November 2008. Last date for submission of application will also be 30th November 2008.

10. Written test will be held on 4th December 2008 in the new college building.

Total time for written examination will be 60 minutes. Time of the written examination will be mentioned in the admit card. Application form should be filled up by the applicant in his/her own handwriting. Attested photocopies of marks sheet and certificate/testimonial of SSC, HSC or equivalent examinations along with four attested copies of recent passport size photographs and, where necessary, the equivalence certificate, poor studentship requisite certificates and documents should be attached with the application. Applications Thaving Incomplete or incorrect Information will stand cancelled and if the information provided is found incorrect after appearing/qualifying in the admission test the examination/results will stand forfeited.
