Two JMB men acquitted

A Dhaka court yesterday acquitted two members of Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB) in a case filed against them for possessing 21 grenade shells.

Judge Mohammad Israil Hossain of the Speedy Trial Tribunal-4 handed down the verdict to Saiful Islam and Mahbub Hossain at a packed courtroom.

In the judgement, the judge said that the two JMB members were acquitted of the charges, as there were no explosive substances in the grenade shells recovered from their possession.

Earlier, the prosecution and the defence had completed their arguments and the court recorded statements of 23 prosecution witnesses.

According to the prosecution, a team of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) raided Hafezia Madrasa at Forzakanda in Narayanganj district on January 7 last year. They recovered 21 grenade shells from there.


