Bank official killed in B'baria road accident

A bank official was killed and nine other people were injured in a collision between two microbuses on Dhaka-Sylhet highway at Malihata village yesterday evening.

The dead was identified as Abul Hasnat Babu, 42, of Ghurakanda village in

Bhairab, Kishoreganj. Local people said a Sylhetbound microbus from Bhairab collided head-on with another microbus Malihata Bishwa

Road, injuring 10 people. Of them, the bank official succumbed to his injuries on the way to hospital.

Drivers and helpers of the microbuses fled the scene, leaving the vehicles behind.

Our correspondent in Patuakhali adds: A motorcyclist, Kamal, 28, was killed in a road accident in Hetalia Badghat area on Patuakhali-Kuakata road on Saturday night.

The accident took place when a Barisal-bound passenger bus from Kuakata hit the motorcycle from behind.

30000 die of lung cancer a yr

Azad said, adding that the lifestyle, food habit and other environmental factors are responsible for diabetes.


Prof Azad said, "We may not be able to eliminate diabetes as it transmitted genetically, so we need to pay attention to check the danger of the disease."






