




Palakar's theatre fest in full gear

Bhelua Sundari and Daak Ghar staged

At the ten-day studio theatre festival by the troupe Palakar, mostly experimental plays are being staged. The festival, beginning on November 21 at Palakar's theatre studio on Natok Shoroni, celebrates five years of the troupe's studio theatre performances. Within a limited space and with a professional approach, Palakar has been staging plays every Thursday and Friday at its studio.

Nine groups from Dhaka and other districts including Centre For Asian Theatre (CAT), Manipuri Theatre of Maulavi Bazar, Space and Acting Research Centre and Department of Music and Drama, DU are participating.

"We consider it a great success to be able to continue with our initiative for the last five years. We have invited troupes at this festival who have, despite all their limitations, produced some

On the second day of the festival, CAT staged their muchacclaimed production "Bhelua Sundari." Directed by Saidur Rahman Lipon, the play is based on a ballad from "Mymensingh Geetika." Kamaluddin Nilu is the directorial advisor of this experimental play.

A musical which is presumed to have originated in 16th century East Bengal (included in an early 20th century collection of ballads known as "Purbo-Bango Geetika), "Bhelua Sundari" is a tragic love story. Performed in a style similar to that of 'pala gaan,' the play narrates the eternal love between Bhelua and Amir Saudagar. In death, Bhelua becomes immortal and Amir embraces the life of a mystic baul.

The cast of the play included Shahadat Hossain, Sabina Sultana, Mezbaul Karim, Rahmatullah Basu, Mohammad Rafi, Raihan Akhter and Abul Kalam Azad. Shafiqur Rahman Bipul, Biplab Sarker and Ahsan Reza Khan were on 'dhol,' harmonium and flute respectively.

Poet Mohammad Rafiq was the chief guest at the second day's programme. Rafiq conferred the festival souvenir on the general secretary of CAT.

Palakar's production "Daakghar" was staged on the third day of the festival. Directed by Shamim Sagar, the play is an experimental adaptation of a short story (with the same title) by Rabindranath Tagore. In the play, Amol, the protagonist is not an adolescent boy as mentioned in the original story, but rather a young girl who dreams of spiritual liberation.

'Gidaler Akhra,' a theatre troupe from Gaibandha will stage their play "Madhumala Madankumar today at 6:30 pm at the festival. The festival is dedicated to the memory of poet, playwright Professor Zia Hyder.

Monirul Islam's exhibition at Bengal begins today
