Sri Lankan troops have killed scores of Tamil Tiger rebels in the past few days and are within "kissing distance" of their

Forces were moving towards the key town of Kilinochchi and inflicting high casualties on the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE), the ministry said.

"Troops are now positioned in kissing distances to the outer defence lines of the LTTE's administrative heartland and main garrison township," it said.

The government has said that the fall of Kilinochchi was imminent since September, but intense rebel resistance and monsoon rains slowed the military

The military "have caused great damages to LTTE leaving scores killed and as peninsula to the rest of the country had severed.

It said troops found 11 bodies of Tiger cadres on Saturday.

The ministry did not give details of its political capital, the defence ministry said casualties, while there was no comment from the guerrillas.

Fighter jets targeted a rebel stronghold and a mortar-launching position in the Paranthan area, four km north of the rebel headquarters, it said.

Pilots confirmed the raids were successful, the military said, without giving casualty details.

### medium-range missile

Iran said that it has test fired vesterday a surface-to-surface missile during manoeuvres in the Sea of Oman, the Fars news agency reported.

A missile-launcher warship fired the medium-range, surface-to-surface Nasr 2 (victory) missile, which hit its target at a 30-kilometre (18 miles) dis-

tance, according to the report. The news agency did not elaborate on the specific range of the missile, only adding that it

was tested for the first time. Iran has test fired missile weaponry several times in the

past few years. The country has always warned of a dire response in the event that it comes under attack

by the United States or Israel.

Hundreds of protesters set cars ablaze, lobbed molotov cocktails at banks and clashed with police in several Greek cities on Sunday in a night-long display of anger at the police killing of a teenager.

The clashes continued through Sunday morning in central Athens, where a group of masked youths threw stones and molotov cocktails at police officers who responded with teargas in front of a university.

## Afghanistan situation 12 militants, 5 soldiers killed in Afghanistan

Twelve Taliban militants and five Afghan soldiers were killed in separate violence across the country over the weekend, officials said yester-

Most the militants died when they attacked a police post in Afghanistan's restive southern Helmand province late Saturday, triggering a gunbattle that also left policemen wounded. Police arrested two militants but another

two escaped, Daud Ahmadi, spokesman for the provincial governor, told AFP. "Nine Taliban were killed and they left their

bodies at the battlefield. Four Taliban and three policemen were wounded," he said. Separately, US-led coalition forces said they

killed three insurgents outside the capital Kabul on Saturday. The Afghan army said five of its soldiers died

and three others were wounded in two roadside bomb explosions on Saturday. The Taliban, who were in power from 1996

to late 2001, have waged a bloody insurgency against Afghan and international forces under Nato and US command in Afghanistan.


