
It was the first fatality during the elections, which are being held in seven stages. Saturday's balloting in the

southern districts of Pulwama and Shopian marked the fifth round of voting.

Four policemen and eight protesters were hurt in scattered demonstrations, said a senior district police officer, asking not to be named. Two were in "critical condition," The 20-year-old man was according to doctor Asif Ahmed at Srinagar's main hospital.

Separatist politicians and rebels have called for a poll boycott, arguing elections strengthen New Delhi's hold over the disputed Muslimmajority region.

However, voters still turned up at polling booths.
