

### 100 out of 266 Magura polling centres risky

As many as 100 polling centres out of 266 in Magura district have been identified as risky, sources in the Office of the Superintendent of Police said.

District Special Branch (SB) of police, however, termed the marked centres as 'important' instead of calling those risky or vulnerable.

SB sources said that they had already informed the higher authorities of the matter. Of the 266 centres in two

constituencies in four upazilas under the district, 100 have been identified as risky while 166 others were marked as normal.

According to the official sources, 42 polling centres out of 137 in Maura-1 constituency and 58 out of 129 polling centres in Magura-2 constituency have been identified as risky. In Magura Sadar upazila 28

polling centres, in Sreepur upazila 20 centres, in Shalikha upazila 26 centres and in Mohammadpur upazila 26 other centres have been marked as vulnerable, official sources said.
