

ACC will be strengthened if elected, says Hasina

Promises industrial park in Pabna while speaking at video conference

Awami League (AL) chief Sheikh Hasina has said if voted to power she will strengthen the Anti Corruption Commission and take steps to ensure accountability at all levels to reduce corruption.

"If AL goes to the power, we will strengthen anti-corruption movement and allow the Anti Corruption Commission to work independently and impartially," she said while speaking at a video conference held at Pabna Town Hall Thursday night. She also replied to questions.

Terming unemployment problem is the root of all evils, Hasina said her government



will try to ensure work for at least one person in a family by setting up industries and reopening the closed ones during the last seven years. The AL chief also promised to create an industrial park in Pabna and revitalise all export processing zones in the country to create employment opportunities.

"In the party poll manifesto we have chalked out the plan for removing unemployment problem."

She said all leaders of her party will have to submit wealth statement to ensure accountability at all levels.

She criticised the four-party alliance government for closing so many mills and factories including the Adamjee Jute Mill and several jute mills in Khulna-Jessore region.

All these will be reopened, she added.

"We don't believe that the head should be chopped to remove headache. Appropriate medicine should

be given for that."

"We will dredge the major rivers of the district to make them navigable."

3 woman 'fighters' in Barisal divn

ANTI-AL LEAFLETS BNP, Shibir men held in Natore

Natore police arrested two leaders of BNP and Islami Chhatra Shibir from Hazratpur Bazar in the city on charges of distributing leaflets containing derogatory remarks about Awami League (AL).

The arrestees are Shamsuddin, 42, president of BNP Kholarbaria union, and Nuruzzaman, 22, Shibir general secretary of Hazratpur Fazil Madrasa unit.

Police said a huge number of anti-AL leaflets, along with some newspaper cuttings containing comments of AL President Sheikh Hasina and her son Joy were seized from their possession on Thursday night.

Locals said the BNP and Shibir leaders jointly photographed the leaflets at Hazratpur Bazar and distributed them among the local people asking them not to vote for AL.

The leaflets said if AL is voted the country will become a colony of India, and a Hindu will be made prime minister.

Local people and police caught them while they were distributing the leaflets.

Police said after investigation, legal action would be taken against them.

Grand alliance eyes grand victory in Kushtia-1

Awami League (AL)-led grand alliance eyes a 'big victory' in Kushtia-1 (Daulatpur) constituency in the upcoming parliamentary election, party leaders said, claiming that its nominee Afaz Uddin Ahmed is 'clearly ahead of his poll rivals'.

They claimed that Afaz Uddin gained popularity and earned respect of people by virtue of being a 'clean' man and the oldest politician in the area after the death of BNP leader Ahsanul Haq Mollah.

Mollah was president of Daulatpur upazila BNP for 22 years and was from Kushtia-1 in three consecutive elections—1991, 1996 and 2001. He died in 2004.

In last three elections, Afaz lost to Mollah with small margins. After the death of Mollah, his son Reza Ahmed Bachchu Mollah was elected from the constituency in 2004 by-election in which no party took part.

Now, Bachchu Mollah is sidelined in BNP due to his involvement with reformist group and for allegedly patronising criminals.

The four-party alliance has nominated Altaf Hossain, senior vice-president of Daulatpur BNP, to contest from Kushtia-1 in the upcoming election. Sources in BNP says a large number of party men who are loyal to Bachchu Mollah are not campaigning for Altaf, which may make his fate uncertain.

On the other hand, as the oldest politician in the area, Afazuddin has a good image in the constituency and earns respect of people of all walks of life.

Besides, as a son-in-law of Mollah family, many in the area thinking Afaz to be alternative to Mollah.

POLICE KILLING OF NILPHAMARI JOURNO Election evokes sad memory as family silently sheds tear

Journalist Kazi Kamruzzaman was killed in police shooting and beating on February 19, 1996 after the 6th parliament election when he was taking photographs of police atrocity on opposition protesters at Nilphamari but neither any judicial enquiry has yet been held nor punishment given to the persons responsible for the killing.

Since 1996 whenever Jatiya Sangsad (JS) elections come and the candidates begin campaigning the family of Kazi Kamruzzaman silently shed tears in his memory.

The journalist was killed in police firing while carrying on professional responsibilities amid political turmoil after the 6th JS election in 1996. Neither any judicial inquiry was held nor the killers were punished despite demand of the journalists' organizations from home and abroad.

Kazi Kamruzzaman's elderly father Kazi Abul Khair said, "Our sorrow knew no bounds when we found that no judicial enquiry was held and the killers were not punished even after passage of long time."

Kazi Md Kamruzzaman was the staff reporter of local weekly 'Nil Sagar'. Main political parties rejected February 15, 1996 parliamentary election results and



launched agitation programmes demanding its cancellation.

In Nilphamari, police arrested some opposition leaders on February 18 night. Opposition parties in a procession on February 19 was going to the office of the deputy commissioner (DC) to hand over a memorandum to him.

On the way a big contingent of police barricaded the procession, charged baton and shot rubber bullets to disperse the participants. Journalist Kamruzzaman was taking shots of police atrocities on the protesters. Police opened fire at about 12:30 a.m. at the protesters at the local municipal market area. Witnesses said that the first bullets hit Kamruzzaman and he fell on the road. He was hit on the head, abdomen and chest. A group of police rushed to him and started beating him with rifle butt till his death.

Police picked up the body of Kamruzzaman into a police van. But police did not hand over the body of Kamruzzaman to his father when he sought his son's body.

AL-BNP CLASH 3 injured in Thakurgaon poll violence

At least three persons including a woman were injured in attack on BNP men by opponent Awami League activists at two villages in Thakurgaon Sadar upazila on Thursday night.

The incident took place during and election meeting at Mujabunni cluster village under Debipur union in Sadar upazila, said Debipur union parishad Chairman Nur Islam and police sources.

"When we were in an election meeting at the house of Aziz Uddin, Awami League activists attacked us, injuring Aziz Uddin and Banu Begum. As other BNP men left the scene and took shelter in the adjacent village, the AL activists chased them and asked the villagers to hand over me to them," said BNP leader Rezwanaul Haque Abu.

The AL activists also damaged 15 motorcycles of BNP activists, Abu said.

When contacted, Awami League leader advocate Mostaq Alam Tulu told this correspondent, "The BNP men entered the village and started distributing money, violating electoral rules. Hearing the news, Awami League activists with the help of local people resisted them."

"As a group of Awami League activists riding motorcycles were passing through the village, Anisur Rahman chanted slogan 'dhaner shis'. Angered, the AL activists beat him," Nargun union parishad Chairman Sayed Poigam Ali said.
