




In "The Curious Case of Benjamin Button," the protagonist played by Brad Pitt heads inexorably toward his own demise equipped with the knowledge of exactly how much time he has left.

As Jim Morrison sang, "No one here gets out alive." Maybe he was referring to a modern-day movie experience?

To watch a Hollywood blockbuster these days is to confront one's own mortality, as some of the fall's biggest prestige titles have the meaning of life -- more specifically, the end of it -- on their minds.

character wracked with guilt over the accidental death of his wife begins a long series of preparations to kill himself. The film's climactic scene has him dying dramatically in a bathtub suicide.




