The military now controls a 142-kilometre (88-mile) stretch of the vital A-9 highway and can supply troops and nearly half a million civilians in Jaffna, the president said.

Lankan war-critic editor shot dead

The editor of a Sri Lankan newspaper that has been highly critical of the island's hawkish government and its war on Tamil rebels was shot dead Thursday, in the second attack on the press in a week.

Gunmen on two motorcycles opened fire at Lasantha Wickrematunga, editor of the Sunday Leader, as he drove to work near the capital Colombo, police spokesman Ranjith Gunasekerasaid.

Wickrematunga, 52, was rushed to hospital but died after three hours of emergency surgery. Colleagues said he had been shot in the chest and head.





40 killed in Karachi slum fire

At least 40 people were killed, more than half of them children, when a fire tore through dozens of homes in a shanty town in Pakistan's largest city Karachi, officials said yesterday.

Initial reports indicated the blaze in the teeming southern port city was sparked by a power wire that fell onto the health minister of Sindh province, Saghir Ahmed.

City police official Majid Dasti told AFP that investigators were also looking into the possibility that residents had started a small fire to beat the cold, and that the wind whipped the flames out of

Twenty-two children were killed in the blaze, which broke out just before midnight (1900 GMT Thursday) when roofs of the huts, said the most residents were asleep, city police Waseem Ahmad said.
