


## CELTAINETICALINES DHAKA TUESDAY JANUARY 13, 2009

Amid this concrete jungle there are still a few patches of greeneries like Ramna Park where the last of the feathery friends dwell in. Some of the magnificent species that visit the park include purple sunbird, golden back woodpecker, magpie robin, common Indian red-vented bulbul, rose-ringed parakeet and the shrike.
