



Citigroup splits amid \$8b loss

Citigroup said yesterday it is splitting up into two businesses as it reported a fourth-quarter net loss of \$8.29 billion - its fifth straight quarterly loss.

In Citigroup's reorganization, one business, Citicorp, will focus on traditional banking, while the other, Citi Holdings, will hold the Secretary Robert Rubin. company's riskier assets.

The move will allow Citigroup to sell or spin off the Citi Holdings assets to raise cash. It also reveals the company's growing focus on backto-basics lending and deposit-gathering, and dismantles the "financial supermarket" created a decade ago.

breakup of Citigroup for years, as the bank

struggled to keep up with its Wall Street peers. Those calls grew louder as the mortgage crisis caused the company's troubles to mount.

There has been harsh blame for Citigroup's woes directed at the board, too - and the company said Friday it plans to get rid of more board members after the recent departure of long-time director and former Treasury

"There has been one announced departure from the board. Together with other anticipated departures, this gives us the opportunity to reconstitute the board and we will do so as quickly as possible," said Richard Parsons, Citi's lead director, in a statement.

Indian govt asked to make nat'l ID register

SC gives the directive to 'check infiltration of Bangladeshis'

The Supreme Court of India asked the Indian government on Thursday to prepare a National Identity of Register to check infiltration of Bangladeshis.

A bench consisting of Chief Justice K G Balakrishnan, Justice P Sathasivam and J M Panchal gave the directive on a public interest petition filed by O P Saxena, President of All India Lawyers Forum for Civil Liberties.

O P Saxena filed the petition seeking a directive from the apex court to the Indian government regarding the deportation of illegal Bangladeshi migrants.

81 houses develop cracks

Residents of five villages near Barapukuria Coalmine Company Ltd (BCMCL) have been living in panic under the open sky since Wednesday plex. night when their houses developed cracks and 300 acres of land subsided two to three feet.

At least 81 houses developed cracks in the five villages, according to locals. BCMCL authorities claimed 23

houses of Moupukur and 53 houses of Kalupara developed cracks and 71 victims of effective preventive acres of land of two villages--Jhigari

and Moupukur--subsided. Angry locals of the affected villages laid siege to the BCMCL complex since Wednesday night, held demonstrations and hurled brickbats at the com-
