Besides, power pump owners are realizing high price for irrigation in different areas of the region. Farmers said they are to

pay one-fourth of reap paddy for supplying water to one bigha since the process of cultivation of the field. On an average, one-fourth of reap sioner (DC) of Narail, declined paddy amounts to four maunds and its price is Tk to comment.

In some areas, the local sub-dealers are requesting farmers to buy the fertilisers with giving them a minimum price so that they are not to incur gross loss, said several
