2 extortionists arrested with firearms

Accordingly, Raju asked the extortionists to receive the amount. Rab members then took position near the spot and arrested them when they were receiving the money.

Robbers kill female Republic Day teacher

An indigenous female teacher was killed and two other fellow teachers were injured as robbers attacked them in a bus on Mymensingh-Tangail highway at Borbaid in Madhupur last night.

The dead was identified as Basanti Mangsang, 48, headmistress of Gaira Missionary school. The two other injured teachers are Monika Nakrek, 30, and Dijani Nakrek, 38, of the same school.

The police said the robbers who were travelling in the bus in the guise of passengers stabbed Basanti indiscrimi- Mailarea.

the bus at Monarbaid. On receiving information, the police rushed to the spot and took Basanti to Jalsatra Missionary hospital. She was later shifted to Mymensingh Medical College and Hospital where she died at around 8:40pm, said indigenous community leader Ajoy A Mri.

Senior government dignitaries, officials, leading businessmen and prominent personalities from the fields of culture, media and academia were also in attendance at the event.


Tiger kills golpata collector in Sundarbans


