

If you're an SOVD (single on Valentine's Day) this year, indulge yourself and mope around all day (ladies suggest generous helpings of chocolate, not sure why. The ditties from this year's playlist address (almost) all cases imaginable related to being single -- dejected, jilted, obsessively persuading, peacefully ruminating, acerbic ranting and celebrating solitude. Check out the following lines, "Every move you make, every vow you break, every smile you fake, every claim you stake, I'll be watching you... Stalkerish? You betcha! Sinister, hell yeah!

"Not As We": Alanis Morissette

Sure it's cruel and unethical to celebrate an individual's -- even if (s)he is a public figure -- personal tragedies, but admit it, no one liked the happy, chirpy, India-thanking, nirvana-seeking Alanis. Fortunately, alt-rock's angriest girl is back in business and she's in top form, thanks to a painful split from her fiancé. "Flavors of Entanglement" (her seventh studio

album) glows with remarkable resentment, poeticising the agonising first steps after a break-up. Sample: "Day one, day one, start over again, step one, step one, I'm barely making sense, for now I'm faking it, 'til I'm pseudo-making it, from scratch, begin again, but this time I as 'I,' and not as 'we...'"

"Superman": Eminem

One of my all-time favourites. Citing excerpts from this profanity-laced rap song would be tough, but here goes (feel free to fill in the blanks): "I'm single now, got no ring on this finger now, I'll never let another chick bring me down,...they come they go, Saturday through Sunday Monday, Monday through Sunday yo, maybe I'll love you one day; maybe we'll someday grow, 'till then just sit your...on that ... runway ... "Chasing Pavements": Adele

Riding high on wave of the "New British Invasion" phenomenon (i.e. Coldplay, James Blunt, Amy Winehouse, KT Tunstall, Corinne Bailey Rae, Joss Stone, Duffy and Estelle), Adele earned the 2009 Grammy Award for Best New Artist, and down and cried today, I can't look at you this is considered her breakthrough act.

"Raindrops Keep Fallin' on My Head": B.J. Thomas

Until I saw the film "Clerks II" and an episode of "The Simpsons" recently, I wasn't familiar with this Academy Award winning (for "Butch Cassidy and the Sundance Kid") Burt Bacharach & Hal David song. It's a wonder how I managed to miss this song for so long, considering it's been covered by numerous artistes/bands and has been featured in several movie soundtracks (including "Forrest Gump" and "Spider-Man 2"). Anyway, the version I'm referring to was recorded by B.J. Thomas (in the early '70s). What's so great about this song? It's a celebration of life as it is. Sure, there are traces of kitsch and the hippy (blame it on the '70s) sense of being content with whatever you got -- the proverbial philosophy, 'life gives you lemons, make lemonade.' But more importantly, it's a supersized dose of unabashed optimism, about living in the moment and enjoying freedom (read singlehood). Sample: "Raindrops keep fallin' on my head, but that doesn't mean my eyes will soon be turnin' red, cryin's not for me, 'cause I'm never gonna stop the rain by complainin', because I'm free, nothin's worryin' me..."

"Shonar Moina Pakhi": Ornob

This Jasimuddin classic was recently resurrected by Ornob (featured in the "Monpura" soundtrack). Now, there's an opinion that Ornob's rendition is a tad whiny. But isn't that what this folk ballad needs? There's a lot of pleading in this song; letting go of the love of one's life is never easy. Ornob's vocals manage to carry the weight of these lines: "Jaiba jodi nithur pakhi bhashaiya mor a(n)khi; e an empty pavement." Sample: "Should I jibon jabar kaley re ekbar jeno give up, or should I just keep chasing dekhi...Amar shonar moina pakhi..." The pavements? Even if it leads nowhere, or result: cathartic.


