

Jewel Rana crowned Khudey Gaanraj

Jewel Rana, 11, was crowned the winner of "Meridian Channel i Khudey Gaanraj 2009" at the talent hunt's grand finale held at National Women's Sports Complex in Dhanmondi on February 13. Jhuma became the first runner up and Porshi was announced the second runnerup.
