Govt unlikely to ratify real estate ordinance

The government is unlikely to approve the real estate development and management ordinance promulgated during the tenure of immediate past caretaker government to protect the rights of buyers and reduce their sufferings.

The ordinance also mentioned that a real estate businessman could not hand over a plot or flat before a housing project is approved by the government.

Once the price of a plot or a flat is paid, December last year with a view to protect the real estate owner will be bound to hand over the property in next three months or repay the money to the buyer if there is any discrepancy in the size of the

The ordinance also made it mandatory for the real estate businessmen to complete construction in accordance with the deadline mentioned in the agreement. Real estate businessmen will have to renovate his construction if required because of faulty construction within two years from the date of handing over the

Every real estate owner will have to maintain the construction for one year after handing over the property to buyer. according to the ordinance.

It is also mandatory for the real estate businessmen to follow structural design and architecture in accordance with the building construction rules and Bangladesh National Building Code. A design also cannot be changed without the approval from the authorities con-

Many of the supervisors, meter readers and other staffs were transferred to different districts following discovery of astonishing level of corruption.

Some of them have eaten away the Titas revenue and tampering with bills, and depriving the government of crores of taka in revenue income. Their stories of becoming millionaire were also appeared on different newspapers.

> Their support was critical, though, in helping the bill vote of 60-38, precisely the number needed for passage. Democratic Sen. Sherrod Brown cast the 60th vote in favor in a nearly deserted Senate, hours after the roll call began. He arrived after a flight aboard a government plane from Ohio, where he was mourning the death of his mother earlier in the week.

> The House vote was 246-183. The legislation, among the costliest ever considered in Congress, provides billions of dollars to aid victims of the recession through unemployment benefits, food stamps, medical care, job retraining and more. Tens of billions are ticketed for the states to offset cuts they might otherwise have to make in aid to schools and local governments, and there is more than \$48 billion for transportation projects such as road and bridge construction, mass transit and high-speed rail.

Democrats said the bill's tax cuts would help 95 percent of all Americans, much of the relief in the form of a break of \$400 for individuals and \$800 for couples. At the insistence of the White House, people who do not earn enough money to owe income taxes are eligible, an attempt to offset the payroll taxes they

In a bow to political reality, lawmakers included. \$70 billion to shelter upper middle-class and wealthier taxpayers from an income tax increase that would otherwise hit them, a provision that the nonpartisan Congressional Budget Office said would do relatively little to create jobs. Also included were funds

for two of Obama's initiatives, the expansion of computerized information technology in the health care industry and billions to create so-called green jobs the administration says will begin reducing the country's dependence on foreign oil.

Friday's events capped an early period of accomplishment for the Democrats, who won control of the White House and expanded their majorities in Congress in last fall's elections. Since taking office on Jan.

20, the president has signed legislation extending government-financed health care to millions of lower-income children who lack it, a bill that President George W. Bush twice vetoed. He also has placed his signature on a measure making it easier for workers to sue their employers for alleged job discrimination, effectively overturning a ruling by the Supreme Court's conservative majority.
