UN urges Lanka, Tigers to avoid 'final bloody battle'

AFP, Colombo/Washington

The UN's humanitarian chief Saturday urged the two sides in Sri Lanka's civil war to avoid a "final bloody battle", expressing deep concern for the tens of thousands of civilians trapped in the combat

island, John Holmes said it was the responsibility of the government and the Tamil Tiger rebels to spare civilians as the warring factions prepare for a final showdown.

Holmes said "tens of deaths and more injuries" of civilians are taking place daily inside the northern Wanni region, where security forces have hemmed the Tigers into a small stretch of jungle along the northeast coast.

"I urge both sides to do everything they can for a peaceful and orderly end to avoid a final bloody battle," he said, stopping short of calling for a ceasefire to allow civilians to leave the embattled areas.
