The People's Republic of Bangladesh has applied financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Emergency 2007 Cyclone Recovery and Restoration Project (ECRRP) and intends to apply part of the proceeds to payment for the consultant services of preparation of future projects for disaster shelters and upgrading the rural network to be implemented by Local Government Engineering Department (LGED).

The services include assisting LGED to support the activists identified in the long-term disaster risks management programme, preparation studies will be carried out for: (i) construction of new disaster shelters and (ii) upgrading of rural road network in the disaster prone areas. This would cover feasibility studies, surveys, for the whole investment and tender designs and bidding documents. The components will finance all engineering studies, surveys, investigation, socio-economic studies social assessment, environmental assessment, and preparation of social management implementation framework (SMIF) as well as resettlement action plan, environmental management framework (EMF) and environmental management plan (EMP) as necessary for project implementation. This will also cover the project implementation plan, financing plan. Total project cost is about US\$300 million covering 15 coastal districts. The duration of the project is about 05 (five) years.

The Consulting Services are thus divided into two phases; **Assignment A** is for comprehensive DSSP study and establishment of updated DSS database covering all vulnerable areas (cyclone and flood affected) for optimal selection of DSSP-1 portion out of country's DSS, its detailed project preparation studies, and preparation of detailed design and bidding documents for two or three packages for first years' implementation; and **Assignment B** is for construction supervision, project management support and preparation of design and bidding of the remaining DSSP-1 works. The contract for Assignment A would be financed from the proceeds of the Credit for ECRRP. The contract for Assignment B would be financed from the DSSP-1 after its approval.

The LGED now invites expressions of interest (EOI) from eligible consultants (firms) to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services (brochures, description of similar assignments, experience in similar condition, availability of the appropriate skills among staff, etc. To prepare a short-list the EOIs would be reviewed on the basis of the following criteria and the short-listed firms will be invited to submit proposals.

- Registration of the firm
- Availability of appropriate skills among staff
- Demonstrated capacity to handle such assignment
- Experience in similar tasks

Consultants may associate to enhance their qualification, but should mention whether the association is in the form of a "joint-venture" or of "sub-consultancy". All members of such an association should have real and well-defined inputs to the assignment, and it is preferable to limit the total number of firms in the association to three.

Special instructions:

- Incomplete/partial EOIs will be rejected.
- Interested firm(s) must provide focused information demonstrating that they are qualified to perform the services.
- The authority reserves the right to accept or reject any or all of the EOI, or annul the EOI process at any stage without assigning any reason(s) whatsoever and without incurring any liability to the affected applicant(s).

Invitation for Expression of Interest (EOI) from the expert organizations/NGOs to implement the Livelihood Skills Education Component of BEHTRUWC Project 2nd Phase

- Government of Bangladesh has undertaken a project entitled "Basic Education for Hard To Reach Urban Working Children (BEHTRUWC) Project (2nd Phase) to provide quality life-skills based basic education and livelihood skills to the urban working children, and advocacy with the national stakeholders to improve environment for working children in six divisional cities over a period of five years. The project targets 200,000 working children of age 10-14 years for life-skills based basic education through establishing 8000 learning centers (LC) for a period of 40 months each and 20,000 children of age 13+ for livelihood skills. Besides, activities are also planned to build the capacity of the stakeholders and advocate at City and National levels to formulate education, social and economic policies in favor of working children and their families and also protecting children from hazardous working environments.
- The BEHTRUWC Project started in 2005. A Project Implementation Unit has been established to implement the overall project activities. This project so far has created basic education opportunities for 166,150 urban working children by operating 6,646 learning centers in six divisional cities. A total of 20 partner NGOs are implementing the basic education activities at the field level. The curriculum and materials for the basic education course have been developed and all the teachers and supervisors are trained accordingly to impart education through inter-active teaching learning method.
- In the BEHTRUWC Project 2nd Phase, a provision has been kept to implement the livelihood skills training program on pilot basis for selected number of learners. The project planned to provide livelihood skills training directly to 5,000 learners through contracting expert organizations/NGOs. These 5,000 learners will be selected by following a set of eligibility criteria. Considering the needs and capability of the learners as well as the labour market demands and opportunities for wage-employment or self-employment, the project planned to pilot four livelihood skills training Models to develop the most viable cost effective and practicable livelihood skills for advocacy and large-scale replication by the concerned stakeholders. Details about the Models are described in the Concept Note on the livelihood skills education component.
- Livelihood skills training will be provided gradually to 5,000 eligible learners in phases during the project implementation period through selected partner organizations. The partner organizations will be selected once to implement livelihood skills training during the project period. The partner organization must have been registered with appropriate authority (NGO Affairs Bureau/Social Welfare Department/Directorate of Women Affairs/Joint Stock Companies of the Government).
- To provide technical livelihood skills directly to the selected 5,000 children through partnering with skills training providers, the Project Director, BEHTRUWC Project 2nd Phase of BNFE under the Ministry of Primary and Mass Education is inviting Expression of Interest (EOI) from the competent organizations. The eligibility criteria for submission of EOI are as follows:
 - Must have registration with appropriate authority.
 - Be a non-political organization.
 - Have a duly approved constitution as per relevant registration act and hold elections regularly as provided for in the constitution.
 - Have established/registered local office premises in the proposed project areas where willing to work.
 - Access to organization's policies by GOB and Donors.
 - Have minimum 5 years working experience after registration in the field of vocational/livelihood skills training. Experience in life skills based basic education, non-formal education, children's rights, gender equality and women and children development would be an added advantage.
 - Have program on vocational/livelihood skills training in a minimum of 2-3 divisional cities for at least 5 years.
 - Have adequate training facilities and competent trainers to provide quality skills training support services. Must the technical and physical capacity to provide quality skills training to at least 50 trainees per course per year.
 - Provision of job placement for graduates of livelihood skills component will be considered an added advantage.
 - Sources of funds, amount of funds and geographical coverage for regular programs i.e. funds from donors, income generating activities, micro-credit programs, donations from individual and/or group, own contribution and other if any.
 - Legally constituted Executive Board with list of membership, their academic and professional background.
 - Has organizational structure with information on number of staff at senior and mid level management in the areas of education, finance, monitoring etc., their academic background, professional experience, roles and responsibilities.
 - System of planning, monitoring, evaluation and reporting (MER) of program activities, problem identification and remedial actions taken.
 - System for maintaining transparent accounts, internal and external audit, and general financial management. Submission of general audit report for the last 3 years based on NGO's fiscal year. Be willing to accept independent external audit.
 - Program progress/evaluation reports prepared by the organization as well as external/third party. Submission of last two evaluation reports prepared internally and externally.
 - Has mechanism on not exposing/endangering beneficiaries, including children to any form of discrimination, abuse and exploitation.
 - Has strong network/association at different levels with other organizations and other professional bodies in a complementary manner, sharing and adopting models of good practice.
 - Has active role in the policy dialogue, advocacy and social mobilization process at community, city and national levels.

- Interested organizations can mention their interest for all or any of the models depending upon their expertise and experiences. For each of the Model, separate EOI need to be submitted.
- One original and six copies of the EOI in English language must cover the eligibility criteria indicated in Para 5, including all documentary evidence that will prove their eligibility according to the above criteria. Photocopies of all relevant supporting documents to show proof of eligibility should be attached as an annex.
