

KHAGRACHHARI SERIAL BLASTS

Charge-framing of 15 JMB cadres deferred

Fourteen out of 15 militants of banned Jama'atul Mujahideen Bangladesh (JMB), arrested in connection with serial bomb blasts case in the district headquarters on August 17, 2005, were produced before the District and Sessions Judge's Court here yesterday to frame charges against them.

The court deferred the charge-framing to April 27 as police could not produce one

of the accused, Mohammad Enayet Ali, in the court from Kashimpur jail in Joydevpur.

After the bomb blasts on Khagrachhari court premises and Shapla Chattar on August 17, 2005, police issued arrest warrants against 18 JMB men including the outfit's kingpins Abdur Rahman and Siddiqui Islam alias Bangla Bhai.

Of them, Abdur Rahman and Bangla Bhai were executed in judges' murder case on March 30, 2007 while another accused, Mohammad Belal, has been absconding

since the incident.

Those produced before the court are Mohammad Ariful Islam, Md Shahidul Islam, Md Emdadul Haq, Md Faruk Hossen, Md Ruhul Amin, Hafez Mohammad Hasan Al Mamun, Md Asaduzzaman, Karim Ali, Ismail Hossen Jamadar, Mohammad Ershad, Md Monju Mia, Ruhul Amin Sufi, Mohammad Abul Kalam Azad and Mohammad Abu Jar.

The law enforcers arrested the JMB militants from different areas of the hill districts after the serial blasts.

Another trader in Natore abducted

Poppy plants, seeds seized in Khulna

A case was filed with Sadar Police Station in this connection.

home from Zamtoli bazaar along with his son Mizanur Rahman.

While narrating the incident, Rahman said, "We set for home by a CNG-run auto-rickshaw with the days' income."

"At a desolate place near Chowgram, about 10 criminals on board two minibuses waylaid us. Identifying themselves as DB policemen, they searched our auto-rickshaw and took away my father with them by a microbus."

Rahman lodged a case with Shingra Police Station. He feared the miscreants might kill him or demand ransom.

"A big network of criminals seems to be involved in the kidnapping", said Singra Police Station acting officer-in-charge (OC) sub inspector (SI) Proddyut Kor. Investigation is going on, he said.

The incident created panic among local traders as two other traders, Sukdev Saha and Rabindranath Saha, were kidnapped in a similar manner with about Tk 2 lakh in their possession about three weeks ago.

However, police managed to rescue them and arrested two of the kidnapers and a driver of a microbus which was used by the gang.

Mohabbat is aide to top outlaw Mrinal

Outlaw Hafizur Rahman Mahabbat, who introduced himself as Zobayer Ali during arrest on February 19, disclosed his real name to the police on Sunday.

BDR personnel arrested Mahabbat, a close aide to Mrinal alias Thakur Das, chief of banned Biplobi Communist Party, at Bomra under Sadar upazila while he was returning home from India.

The outlaw concealed his real name and address from the BDR men and introduced himself as Zobayer Ali, son of Dalil Uddin of Gobindapur village in Koira upazila under Khulna district, sources said.

Police sent him to jail on February 19 as Zobayer Ali. But on secret information, the law enforcers interrogated him at Satkhira jail gate on February 22 and came to know his real name and address, sources added.

Police yesterday produced him before the Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court seeking a seven-day remand. Judge Ranu Bilkis Banu will hear the prayer today.

6 outlaws get life for murder

The Speedy Trial Tribunal, Rajshahi, yesterday awarded life imprisonment to six operatives of outlawed Purbo Banglar Communist Party (PBCP) for killing union council chairman Abdus Sobhan Chowdhury in Naogaon.

The convicts are Babu alias Sagor, Akbar-1, Abdus Sabur, Zahidul Islam, Abdul Latif and Chanchal.

Judge ATM Mesbaudoula also fined them Tk 10,000 each, in default, they are suffer another year in jail.

The court also acquitted four accused, Ibrahim Mondol, Shariful, Akbar-2 and Mahfuzur Rahman Jewel, as charges brought against them were not proved.

Three other accused-Jalal, Shafiqul and Sohel Rana--

were exempted from the case following their death in "shootouts" with the law enforcers.

Abdus Sobhan Chowdhury, chairman of Muniary Union Council and headmaster of Naidighi High School in Atai upazila of Naogaon district, was hacked to death by the outlaws while returning home at Naidighi from the district headquarters in a passenger bus on August 30, 2002.

Chowdhury's wife Ferdousi Yasmin lodged a murder case with Atrai Police Station and Sub-Inspector Rezaul Islam submitted the charge sheet to the magistrate's court against 13 PBCP men on August 3, 2003.

The case was shifted to the tribunal in July last year and 27 witnesses were cross-examined during the trial.

Swindler finally put behind bars

A 'swindler' accused of cheating people of huge amount of money upon false assurance of sending them abroad was sent to jail yesterday.

The accused, Sayeed Mahmud Anisur Rahman alias Firoze hailing from village Khalishacholi of Chandpur, was arrested from Sylhet city on Sunday.

He started living in Sylhet city over a year ago and took a large amount of money from a number of people of Bralekha in Moulvibazar and Golapganj in Sylhet for sending them abroad, police said.

He took Tk 4.9 lakh from Mainuddin of village Nij Dhakadakhin in Golapganj for sending him to Spain, Tk 2.62 lakh in advance for sending Abdul Zabbar to England for Tk 11 lakh, Tk 1.04 lakh in

advance from Badrul Islam of Baghatkor and Tk one lakh in advance for sending Faizur Rahman of Pakhiala to Canada, police quoted the victims as saying.

He also took Tk 70,000 from Tajul Islam of Gazitka in Barlekha and Tk 1.5 lakh from Monaf Ahmed of Majibhag for sending them to Spain, they said.

After passing months in the name of 'arranging things', Sayeed gave bank cheques to some of them, but the cheques were dishonoured, said the victims.

To evade the depositors, he changed his house in Sylhet city several times.

After Haji Faruque Ahmed of Barlekha filed a case against Sayeed with the Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court in Moulvibazar, the court issued warrant of arrest.

Sylhet Kotwali police arrested Sayeed from his rented house in Sylhet city Sunday night and sent him to Barlekha Police Station.

He was produced before the court yesterday and the court sent him to jail.

Newsmen in Netrakona stage protest

SAD TALE OF A SCHOOL DROPOUT

Tempted and threatened, Maimuna joins the gang

A school dropout teen-age girl, tempted by assurance of Tk 100 daily allowance and Tk 5,000 monthly pay, joined a gang of young robbers in the district about a month ago.

The girl, Maimuna Akhter Shilpi, was also threatened with death if she did not join the group.

She said this in her statement under Section 164 to Chandpur Magistrate Md Aminul Islam on February 17.

Maimuna, daughter of Serajul Haque of Rairree village under Shahrasti upazila, told police and magistrate that she stopped going to school when she was a student of class four and she is now 18 years old.

She, however, seemed younger.

"About one month ago, Rubel, Sagar, Anwar, Zakir and Mukted told me to accompany them to rob a house. They said my job



would be to knock on the door, address the women of the house as maa [mother], khala [aunt] etc and persuade them to open the door.

"I would secretly go with the gang at night. I took shelter at the targeted house, presenting myself as a helpless girl. I would open the door for the gang members at a suitable time.

"On the first day, five of the gang accompanied by seven to eight unknown robbers who came by hired CNG auto-rickshaws com-

mitted robbery at the house of Shafiuallah at Chandipur village. On the same night they also robbed two houses at Rairree village," she said.

On February 4, they went to rob the house of father-in-law of an OC at Panchbasti village in Barura.

As the inmates cried for help, people caught Maimuna while other robbers managed to flee, she said. She was handed over to Barura police who shifted her to Shahrasti Police Station.

Chandpur Superintendent of Police Krishnapada Roy said Maimuna was made accused in the case filed for January 13 robbery incident at the house of Abdul Karim Patwari in Shahrasti upazila.

She was taken on a three-day remand while the other accused in the case are still on the run.
