BDR mutiny condemned, tolerance of armed forces lauded

Different organisations and human rights bodies yesterday continued to condemn the killing of the army officers at Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) headquarters in the city.

They also prayed for the salvation of the departed soul of those army officers and conveyed deep sympathy to the bereaved family members.

Transparency International Bangladesh (TIB) in a statement appreciated the tolerance of the armed forces in such a crisis.

"The real culprits will have to be identified through proper investigation and stern actions should be taken against them so that such

types of heinous incidents don't happen in the future," read the statement signed by TIB Senior Advocacy Officer Imam Uddin.

Manusher Jonno, a human rights organisation, said the death of the army officers is an irreparable loss for the nation but the government and armed forces should go forward to resolve the crisis peacefully.

Dhaka Club Ltd has cancelled all its entertainment programmes as a mark of respect to the slain army officers.

Shushashoner Jonno Nagorik (Sujan) in a statement demanded proper investigations into the incident and trial of the culprits.

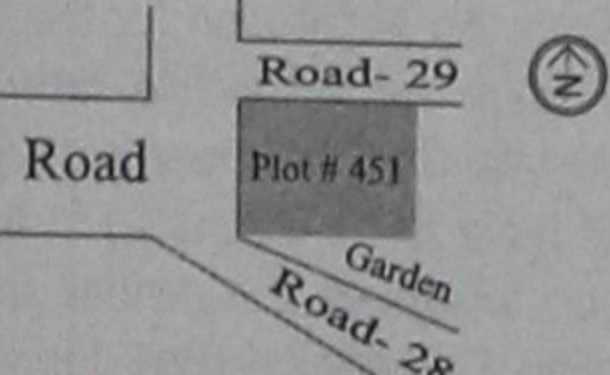
