Nobody knows how the three pedestrians killed during the BDR mutiny were laid to rest by their families as neither the government nor the media is paying any attention to them.

A number of Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) personnel, who fled the BDR headquarters at different times during February 25-26, have told The Daily Star how a group of masked Jawans forced them to take up firearms during the first hour of mutiny.

"Take up arms, else none of you will survive," a BDR Jawan from Battalion-24 quoted a masked Jawan, brandishing a gun and firing blank shots into the air, as saying.

Several dozen BDR personnel, waiting to report back to duties yesterday, spoke to this correspondent about the events of the fateful, February 25.

The authorities have divided the BDR men reporting back to duty into two groups -- those reporting back in uniforms were asked to line up in front of the Pilkhana headquarters gate at Zigatola, and those without uniforms were sent to the Abahani sports field in Dhanmondi.

The BDR soldiers were present at Darbar Hall in the morning and said that a group of men in BDR uniforms wearing red,






A mother deer yesterday was unable to quench the thirst of her starving young one, which was desperately trying to suck milk from her.


