

"According to Bangladeshi Adivasi Forum, there are at least 45 Adivasi communities in the country," says Ferdousi. "Naturally they have vibrant cultural traditions. However, except for a few, most of the Adivasi communities don't have apposite representation and exposure in the mainstream," she adds. "For the last three years, Shammilito Shangskritik Jote, Padatik and Bashonto Utshab Committee have been incorporating performances by Adivasi artistes in their programmes.

Ferdousi also feels not much is being done to preserve and promote the Adivasi cultural practices by

the state. "There are 'Upojatiya Cultural Academies in our country but I don't think they are effective. First of all, I have issues with the term 'Upojatiya,' which means tribal. You're dehumanising someone when you refer to him/her as 'tribal.' Then there is the concern of recruiting Bengali teachers/ trainers at these academies. Isn't it logical to have Adivasis as trainers when grooming of Adivasi cultural practices is concerned? These academies can also play a key role in teaching Adivasi children their mother language," she says.


