Road crashes kill 4

Four people were killed and 11 others injured in separate road accidents in Sirajganj, Satkhira and Thakurgaon yesterday.

Our correspondent in Sirajganj reports: Two people were killed and seven others injured in a road accident on the Dhaka-Bogra highway at Kodda Bheranga at Kamarkhanda in the district.

The accident took place at around 5:30am when a Bograbound goods-laden truck collided head-on with a brickladen truck, killing the driver of brick-laden truck Rabiul Islam, 33, on the spot and injuring eight others.

Of the injured, an unidentified man succumbed to his injuries on the way to Sirajganj Sadar Hospital.

The rest of the injured, mostly day-labourers, were admitted to local hospital and clinics.

Our correspondent in Satkhira adds: A businessman was killed in a road accident in the district.

The victim was identified as worldwide, he said. Jagadish Chandra Mondal, 45. The accident took place

when a Khulna-bound truck hit the motorcycle the victim was riding on at Tala on Satkhira-Khulna highway,

BSS adds: A man was killed and four others were injured in a road accident on Thakurgaon-Dinajpur highway in Thakurgaon.

The accident occurred

when a speeding truck knocked a human hauler from behind, leaving five people

They were rushed to Thakurgaon Sadar Hospital

where an unidentified man succumbed to his injuries. Two of the injured were released after giving first aid, but the condition of Rubel and Barjo was stated to be critical.

DU VC urges ex-students to extend cooperation



The VC said this at the 3rd Conference of Dhaka University Ex-Students Association (1981-90) at the TSC auditorium.


Association President Mahbubur Rahman Shaheen, who chaired the conference, announced that the association would give 10 scholarships every year to poor and meritorious students of the university.





