Golap Kazi, a guard, and Abdur Rahim seizurelist of the grenade where he signed. Howlader, a sweeper of Railway Super Market, said this as Judge Masdar Hossain of the Speedy Trial Tribunal-1 Dhaka was recording their statements.

The court also fixed March 18 for next hearing of the case and summoned five others to appear before the court.

In his deposition, Golap told the court that he was on duty at the market on August 21, 2004. But he heard sounds of grenade explosions at Bangabandhu Avenue at about 4:30pm. He then closed all collapsible gates of the market. After a while, he found a grenade inside the market and soon informed the law enforcement agencies of it.

Former deputy minister Abdus Salam Pintu told the court that no key witnesses were produced before the court although several dates have expired. He was implicated in the case, as he was in-charge minister of Gopalganj district. Moreover, he was implicated in the case as per direction of a foreign mission, Pintu said. The 22 people accused of launching the

grenade attacks on the rally include Pintu, Harkatul Jihad (Huji) chief Mufti Abdul Hannan, Huji members Abu Sayeed, Shahdatullah Jewel, Rafiqul Islam alias Rafiq, On hearing the news, police, Rapid Action Abu Taher and Maulana Tajuddin.

Fourteen of the accused, including Pintu and Hannan, who are now in jail, were produced before the court during yesterday's Eight others, including Pintu's younger

brother Maulana Tajuddin, have been absconding since the cases were filed.

At around 2:00pm, some students of City College attacked students of Ideal College and the clash ensued.

Students of both the colleges chased and counter chased each other in front of the restaurant.

They also pelted brickbats to each other, leaving five of both the colleges injured, police said.

At one stage, the agitating students of City College stormed into the principal's room of Ideal College and ransacked the furniture and windowpanes of the room.
