Khandaker Delwar Hossain | programmes are: the NGOs will have to have Tk 40 lakh in mini mum credit and 1,000 borrowers to get licences from the MRA. In 2007, the government formed the MRA and as per its

rules, no NGO in Bangladesh can run microcredit programmes without licence. A total of 4,240 microfinance NGOs have so far applied for

licences. The MRA has already issued licences to 411 and cancelled the activities of 600 NGOs. MRA officials said the remaining applicants will have

to take licences by December 31 by fulfilling the conditions. Otherwise they would not be allowed to operate.
