Set up directorate to protect consumers' rights: CAB

Bangladesh (CAB) yesterday called on the govern ment to formulate rules under the recently passed Consumers' Protection Law 2009 as soon as possible in order to make it effective soon.

It also demanded establishment of a directorate of consumer welfare by appointing an eligible person so that consumers can lodge their allegations against the consumers' rights violators.

Members of the association made the call at a press conference at its office in the

They hoped that the government would enforce the law through a gazette notification immediately.

To create awareness among the common people about the consumers' rights, the association also demanded steps to observe April 1 as National Consumers' Rights Day from the next year as the bill was passed on the day in the Jatiya Sangsad.

CAB President Borhan Uddin said, "Now consumers have got a legal instrument to fight against the violators through passing the bill. If the government establishes a directorate and completes other related activities, it would be effective properly."


