## Subject: New Zealand Commonwealth Scholarships-2010

Applications are invited from Bangladeshi nationals for study under New Zealand Commonwealth Scholarships-2010.

**Categories of Scholarships:**

- a) One year masters course or equivalent degrees (number of scholarship-2).
- b) Doctoral degrees, of up to three years duration (number of scholarship-1).
2. Scholarship will be awarded in the following priority areas as set by ZAID:
  - a) Sustainable rural livelihoods, b) Education, c) Primary health, d) Governance, e) Trade and development, f) Conflict prevention and reconstruction, g) Environmental studies, h) Bio-security, i) Food safety, j) Tourism management and k) Agribusiness development.
3. Candidates must have a 4 years graduate degree or 3 years honours and 1 year master degree.
4. Regarding area of study, candidates should mention any one of the area of study as mentioned in para-2.
5. A first degree of first class (GPA 3 out of 4 or GPA 4 out of 5) honours level or a degree of first class (GPA 3 out of 4 or GPA 4 out of 5) and a relevant postgraduate degree.
6. Candidates can apply for only one area of study.
7. The applicants must be under 40 years of age.
