The Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) is assisting the Government of Bangladesh through its Department of Fisheries in rehabilitating vulnerable households in the riverine and coastal areas that were affected by cyclone Sidr. For this purpose FAO has established an Emergency and Rehabilitation Coordination Unit in the office of the FAO Representative in Bangladesh.

The rehabilitation work is carried out under various projects funded by different international donors. Under some of these projects there is provision for the distribution of small wooden boats for multipurpose use, including fishing. FAO therefore intends to support the construction of large numbers of such boats for distribution to selected households. The boats will be of the traditional type, motorized with in-board or outboard engines and of a length between 18 and 30 feet.

FAO wishes to acquire the craft by contracting suitable suppliers to produce them, either directly or through employing the supervisory services of a recognized NGO.

The contractor(s) / NGOs will be selected through the process of competitive bidding in accordance with FAO rules and regulations. In order to qualify for participation in the bidding process the supplier must (i) be a registered company in Bangladesh, (ii) have audited financial statement for at least three years, and (iii) not have pending actions against the company in any court.
