DCC sitting on billboard mess

Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) has failed to take any effective measures to prevent random installation of advertising hoardings, mostly illegal, posing serious risk to city dwellers, especially during storm.

Only in the last week, three billboards collapsed in different parts of the capital.

On May 6, a young man died and three others sustained injuries when a billboard broke down on a phone shop near the Zia International Airport during storms. However, no one was reported injured in two other incidents--one in front of Siddheswari Girls High School on Bailey Road on May 3 and another at Technical in Mirpur yesterday.

The haphazard setting up of billboards and other advertisement boards are also impairing the beauty of the city, said residents of different areas.

When it came to launching the drive against illegal advertising hoardings the DCC has been conspicuous by its absence over the last eight months, said a DCC official.

Another billboard collapses

A billboard collapsed on a high voltage electric line above Darus Salam police outpost at Technical in the city's Mirpur early yesterday.

Sources said nine policemen who were asleep at the outpost narrowly escaped accident, as the billboard could not fall on the outpost because of the electric wire.

Following the killing, the extortionists threatened to kill more

workers if their demand was not met. The threat was made over a cellphone.

The dead boy was identified as Mohammad Sharif, 16. Sharif was visiting his brother Mohammad Abdullah, 21, who worked as the labour supervisor of the under construction building at North Kazipara in Kafrul.

200 killed in Pakistan anti-Taliban push

Over 100,000 people flee fighting as authorities lift curfew

Pakistan's military said yesterday they had killed between 180 and 200 insurgents in the last 24 hours in their fierce offensive to push Taliban fighters out of the Swat valley in the northwest.

"During the last 24 hours, as many as 180boarded the boat after taking | 200 miscreants have been killed in various areas of Swat / Shangla by security forces," the military said in a statement written in English. The military has been pounding the Swat

valley and several nearby districts since late last month after Taliban fighters advanced to within 100 kilometres of Islamabad despite a February peace deal.

Earlier Pakistani security forces killed 26 militants in a gunbattle with Taliban fighters Sunday after they attacked a security post in a tribal area near the Afghan border, officials said.

About 150 armed militants stormed a paramilitary Frontier Corps checkpost in Ambar district in the rugged tribal region of Mohmand






