

# Faiz Ahmed talks about his passion for arts

Shilpangan is one of the active art galleries in Dhaka, which opened in January 1992. Faiz Ahmed, a veteran journalist and rhymester, is the founder of the gallery. Ahmed was the president of Samilito Sangskritik Jote and has been contributing to our cultural arena for a long time.

At present, there are many art galleries in Dhaka. Ahmed comments, "For a long time, I had a dream to open a gallery where artists can interact with each other, sell their paintings and the public can develop a taste for artworks. Before the establishment of Shilpangan, there was no full-fledged private art gallery in our country. After it opened, a number of galleries were set up in the city, but mainly for profitable purposes. They wanted to do

business rather than contribute to the art scene. "From the onset, we have been trying to work with prominent artists. At our first exhibition we displayed the works of renowned artists such as Zainul Abedin, Quamrul Hasan, Shafiuddin Ahmed, Qayyum Chowdhury, Mohammad Kibria,

S.M. Sultan, Monirul Islam, Shahbuddin Ahmed and others. At my gallery, Monirul Islam, Shahabuddin Ahmed and Maruf Ahmed have held exhibitions three to five times," says Faiz Ahmed.

Other veteran painters, Rafiqun Nabi, Hashem Khan and Qayyum Chowdhury have also held exhibitions a number of times at Shilpangan. "Here promising and amateur painters also get the chance to exhibit their works and our aim is to promote budding talents. Twelve years ago, Shilpangan organised a combined exhibition with one of the largest galleries in France, where Picasso's print, Paul's painting, Braque's tapestry and other internationally recognised artists' works were on display. We have already had 130 exhibitions. Shilpangan has encouraged many art enthusiasts, connoisseurs and viewers. 'To love art and living with art, 'is our motto," Ahmed says.

"Ambassadors, bureaucrats, poets, intellectuals, writers, professors, critics and academics regularly visit the gallery on various occasions and take part in inaugural and cultural programmes," Faiz Ahmed remarks.

## Almodovar, Penelope give men their due in Embraces

Expect more male characters from Pedro Almodovar, whose credits include such female-cantered films as "All About My Mother," "Volver" and "Women on the Verge of a Nervous Breakdown."

With his latest Penelope Cruz collaboration, the Cannes Film Festival entry "Broken Embraces," Almodovar strikes some equality between the sexes and says he plans to feature more men in future films.

"There are as many male parts as there are female parts," Almodovar said before the premiere Tuesday night of "Broken Embraces." "So it's perfectly balanced.

"So far, my male characters intimidated me somewhat, because for a male character, I had to take myself as a reference," said Almodovar, who won Academy Awards for foreign-language film with "All About My Mother" and original screenplay for "Talk to Her." "But now I feel less and less intimidated, and so now, you're going to find more and more male characters in my films."

At the heart of "Broken Embraces" is a tragic love triangle involving film director Mateo (Lluis Homar), actress Lena (Cruz) and her jealous sugar daddy (Jose Luis Gomez), a wealthy businessman producing their movie.

Their story is told through flashbacks as Mateo, now a blind screenwriter who has sought to block out his past, chronicles a furtive affair that ends in catastrophe: The dark melodrama is sweetened with typical Almodovar comic touches, including a film within the film. This consists of snippets of a comedy Mateo is shooting that was inspired by "Women on the Verge of a Nervous Breakdown," the 1988 film that helped establish
