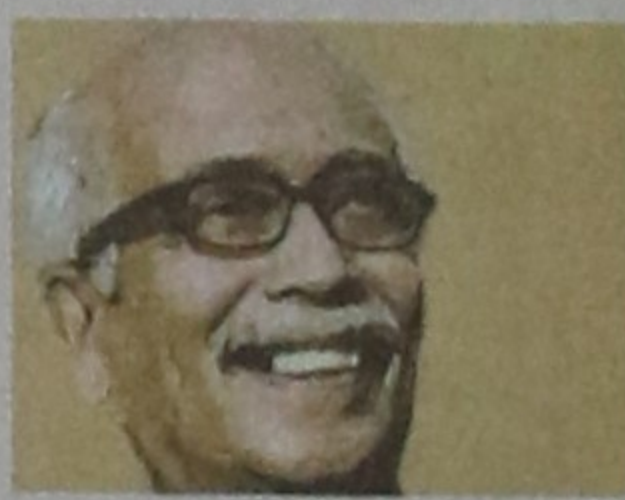

Jagaran's musical offering to Nazrul

To celebrate the 110th birth anniversary of our National Poet Kazi Nazrul Islam, cultural organisation Jagaran Sangskriti Charcha O Gabeshona Kendra, held a two-day programme at Music and Dance Centre, Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy, starting from May 25.

Titled "Aaj Srishti Shukher Ullashey," the event featured solo performances by leading and upcoming Nazrul singers, poetry recitation, dance performances and more. An exhibition on rare photographs of the poet was also held at the venue.

On May 25, the show started with a dance performance by artistes of Nrityalok. The composition, with Nazrul's poem "Bidrohi" recited by Kazi Sabyasachi in the background, was choreographed by Kabirul Islam Ratan.

Performances by Khalid Hossain, Sujit Mustafa, Rahat Ara Geeti, Yakub Ali Khan, Moshina Akhand Jhuma and Kalpana Anam followed. The last performance of the day was by Khairul Anam Shakil. A group recitation was performed by members of Udichi. Artistes of Spandan and Nandanik staged group dances.

On the second day, the programme kicked off with a duet dance performed by Sharmila Bandopadhyay and Arno Kamolika with two Nazrul songs on rain -- "Megher hindoley" and "Rum jhum jhum badolo nupur." The performance featured three dance styles -- Bharatnatyam, Odissi and creative.

A solo performance by noted Nazrul singer Sadya Aftreen Mallick followed. Mallick rendered three Nazrul Sangeet -- "Bhuli kemoney," a 'kabya-geeti' "Bideshini chini chini" and a 'khyal' in



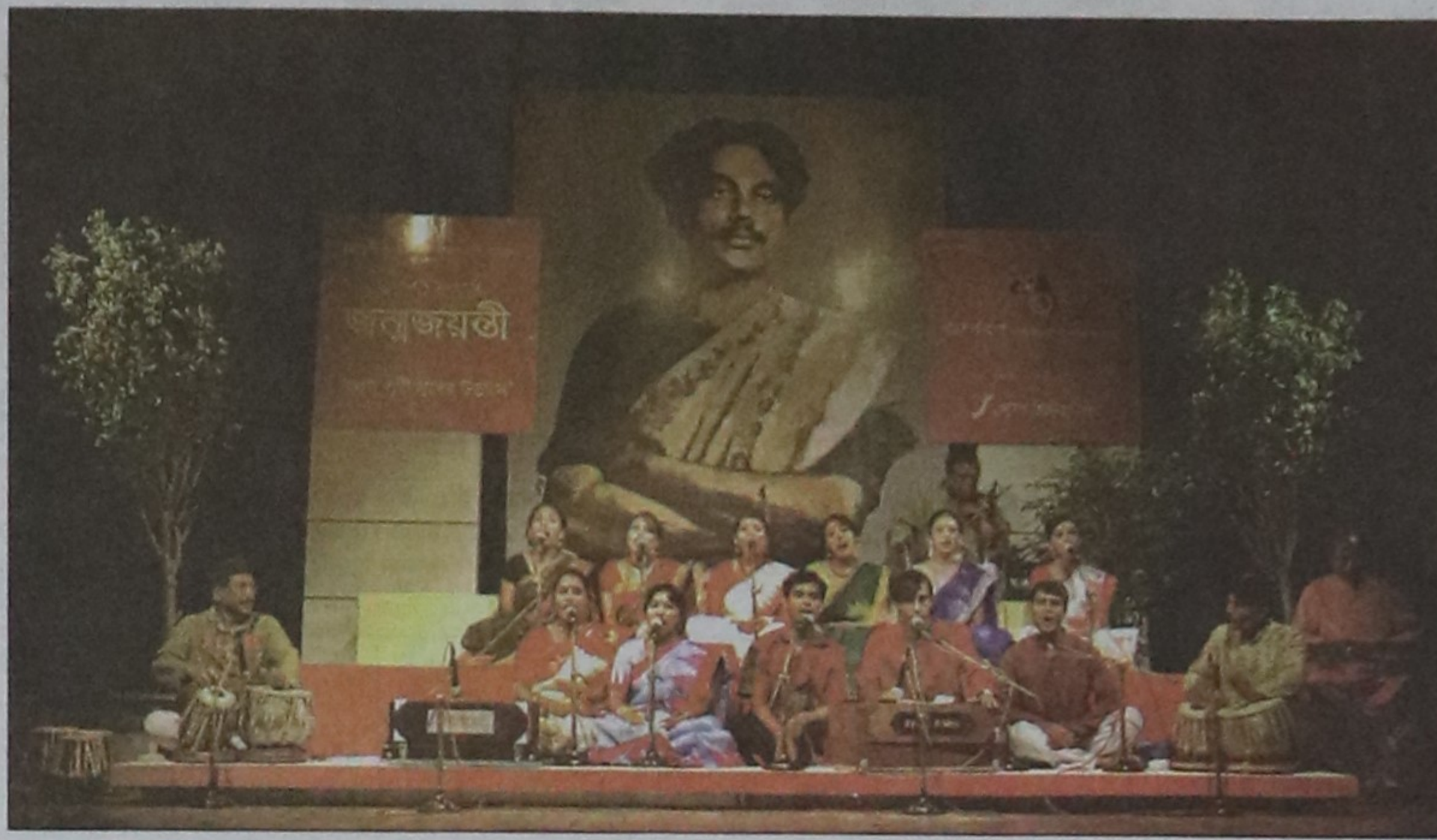
'Raaga Hambir,' "Ajo ka(n)dey kanan-e koyelia."

Next on stage was Shahid Kabir Palash. Palash sang, "Cheo na sunayana," "Ami jedin roibona go" and "Mon-e porey aaj."

Other performers at the programme were Salahuddin Ahmed, Sharmin Shathi Islam, Sanjay Roy, Swarnamoyi Mandal, Didarul Islam and Rezaul Karim.

Group performances were staged by Nibedan and Jagaran. Jharna Sarkar and Rezina Wali Lina presented spirited recitations.

The event ended with a performance by virtuoso singer Fatema Tuz Zohra. This was the first programme celebration Nazrul birth anniversary by Jagaran. The event was supported by Step Media Centre.
