Army chief visits Patuakhali

Army chief Gen Moeen U Ahmed yesterday visited cyclone-hit Nachnapara under Kalapara upazila of the district. He reached Kalapara at about 1:30pm, visited damaged flood control dam and exchanged views with locals. He also saw the activities of mobile health camp run by army personnel in the area. Later, the army chief distributed relief goods among 200 cyclone victims.

3 of a family electrocuted

Three members of a family were electrocuted at village Baishbunia under Kathalia upazila in Jhalakathi district yesterday. The deceased were identified as Ruhul Amin, 40, his brother's wife Khadiza Begum, 28, and his son Rajib, 13. Police and local people said Rajib first came in contact with a live electric wire snapped by Cyclone Aila when he was fishing in a nearby water body at about 10:00am. His father Ruhul Amin and aunt Khadiza met their tragic end when they tried to save Rajib. Police recovered the bodies and sent them to Jhalakathi Sadar Hospital morgue for autopsy.

Nine bombs found in B'baria

Police recovered nine bombs from Eidgah field in the district headquarters Friday night. Acting on a tip-off, law enforcers from Brahmanbaria Sadar Police Station went to the spot at around 10:30pm and found the bombs lying abandoned in the field. They took the bombs to the police station where explosive experts will defuse them.

Six hurt as AL, BNP clash

Six people were injured, one of them critically, in a clash between the supporters of an Awami League (AL) leader and a BNP leader over a disputed land in Moheshpur upazila yesterday. There had been a long-standing conflict over the land between AL leader Abdul Malek and BNP leader Abdul Latif at Bhairaba village, said Moheshpur OC. Both the groups used lethal weapons during the clash. The injured were admitted to Jhenidah and Moheshpur hospitals.

20 hurt in Bandarban clash

At least 20 people were injured in a clash over a disputed land at Companypara under Lama upazila yesterday. A rivalry grew over possession of the land between two groups of villagers, one led by Abdul Gafur and the other by Fazar Ali, police and locals said. Fazar Ali and his men attacked Gafur while he was working in his cropland field in the morning. As the news spread, Gafur's men counter-attacked causing injuries to 15 people from both the groups.

PROTEST AGAINST 'ASSAULT' ON FELLOW

MMCH interns ransack rooms

Agitated interns ransacked four rooms including the rooms of Emergency Department and the director of Mymensingh Medical College Hospital (MMCH) in protest against 'assault' of a colleague by a patient's attendants on Friday night. The interns also beat up patient's attendant Rabbi, seriously injuring him. Eight-month-old Labbi, daughter of Abdul Gani of village Kaltapara in Gouripur upazila, was admitted to the MMCH at around 10:00pm on Friday but she was not given any treatment after two hours of her admission, said her relatives. As Labbi's maternal uncle Rabbi went to the interns' room and requested them to take necessary steps for her treatment, serious altercation followed. The intern doctors caught Rabbi, took him to the Doctor's Club and beat him mercilessly. Critically injured Rabbi was admitted to MMCH. Later the intern doctors ransacked four rooms of MMCH. The hospital authorities took quick initiatives to settle the matter with the intern doctors. When contacted, MMCH Deputy Director Dr Siddiqur Rahman claimed that the intern doctors were attacked first and later they beat up Rabbi, the patient's attendant. Following the initiative taken by authorities, the intern doctors joined their work shortly, he said. The MMCH authorities lodged a case with Kotwali Police Station after the incident. Police arrested Rabbi.

ANNIVERSARY OF ZIA'S DEATH

16 BNP men hurt as political rivals foil programme in 3 dists

Sixteen BNP activists were injured as unruly people allegedly belonging to Jubo League and Chhatra League yesterday foiled the programmes arranged on the 28th death anniversary of former president BNP founder Ziaur Rahman in Barisal and Bhola districts. Activists of Jubo League and Chhatra League, who staged a show of strength at Banaripara upazila town in Barisal, ransacked the microbus carrying BNP leader Sarfuddin Ahmed Santu. Santu, a former lawmaker candidate from Barisal-2, was on his way to attend Zia's death anniversary programme scheduled to be held near the upazila agriculture office. Activists of BNP, Jubo Dal and Chhatra Dal -- Kamal Hossain, Zakir Hossain, Khalilur Rahman Chowkidar, Nannu Mridha, Bablu Mridha, Dr Saifur Rahman and Lal Mia were injured as their political rivals beat them up. The scheduled programmes on Zia's death anniversary at Banaripara was cancelled, said Banaripara municipality BNP Secretary Golam Faruk. Protesting the attack, the BNP activists kept Barisal-Banaripara-Swarupkathi road at Guthia blocked for more than two hours. In Daulatkhan upazila town under Bhola, AL men attacked the BNP programme venue at Uttar Bazar yesterday morning. They burnt tyres, looted and damaged kitchen utensils and the food cooked to feed destitute. Six BNP activists including Rafiq Howladar, Yasin, Shahjahan and Khokan were injured in this attack, said Nazimuddin Howladar, Daulatkhan upazila BNP president. In Lalmoan upazila town of Bhola, AL men attacked injured three BNP men and drove them out of their programme venue near the police station in the morning. Our Staff Correspondent from Rajshahi adds: Four masked motorcycle riders fired a gunshot near the District Council auditorium in Natore town where the local BNP was holding a meeting on the death anniversary of late president Ziaur Rahman yesterday noon, BNP men alleged. Our Magura Correspondent reports: BCL men foiled a discussion programme by Magura district BNP to mark Ziaur Rahman's death anniversary. The attackers who stormed the office on Mokhesur Rahman Road in the town at around 11:30am, damaged its signboard and furniture. Police team led by Magura Sadar Police Station Officer-in-Charge Sagir Mian brought the situation under control.

Attack on BDR men in Teknaf, 9 held

The law enforcers have arrested nine miscreants who attacked BDR personnel at Kauk Khali ghat under Teknaf Municipality early Friday. The arrestees are Syed Akbar, 30, Abul Hossain, 22, Mohammad Hossain, 23, Mohammad Idris, 20, Mohammad Rafique, 25, Mohammad Shaker, 26, Foyez Ullah, 23, Rahim Ullah, 34 and Anwar Hossain, 24. BDR sources and witnesses said a gang of miscreants, led by Syed Akbar, tried to loot a huge amount of shrimp imported from Myanmar at Kauk Khali ghat at around 1:30 am on Friday. When the BDR men obstructed, the miscreants swooped on them injuring Nayek Subedar Mohammad Yusuf, jawan Ziaul Haq, businessmen Mamunur Rashid and HM Ershad. Additional BDR troops reached the spot and brought the situation under control.

CYCLONE AILA  
48,400 houses, 281km roads destroyed in Khulna district

Cyclone Aila has fully destroyed 48,400 houses and 281 kilometre roads in Khulna district, according to district control room sources. It has partially damaged 46,458 houses and 517 kilometre roads. The sources said ten academic and religious institutions were completely damaged while 250 others partially in the six upazilas affected by May 25 cyclonic. The district administration has so far distributed Tk 32.21 lakh to over five lakh people of 1,11,386 families in the upazilas. The control room sources further said the cyclone has fully damaged crops on 1,854 acres of land in the district. Besides, the calamity has damaged 514-km embankment and two bridges. About 24 tonnes of flattened rice, two and a half tonnes of molasses, two tonnes of fried rice (Muri) and 1,371 tonnes of rice were distributed among the victims, the additional deputy commissioner (ADC) of Khulna said. Besides, 150 tents, 4,200 water cans, 2,000 pieces of lungis and 3,800 pieces of saris, 7,000 packets of orsaline packets and 5,000 water purification tablets were also distributed in the affected areas. As many as, 45 medical teams are rendering healthcare services to the cyclone victims. About 66,850 people, including women and children, are still staying in cyclone centres of six upazilas, the ADC said. Re-polling in Chhaganaiya UZ tomorrow BSS, Feni  
Re-polling in 10 centres of Chhaganaiya Upazila (UZ) Parishad will be held tomorrow. Polling in those centres was postponed due to untoward incidents on January 22. Later, the Election Commission (EC) formed an investigation committee with the district and sessions judge as its head. After an inquiry, the committee found irregularities in voting at the centres and suggested to hold fresh polls. A total of 19 candidates are in the race. Of them, eight are vying for chairman post, seven for vice-chairman (male) and four for vice-chairman (female) posts. The district administration has taken all preparations to hold the re-election in a free, fair and peaceful manner. A magistrate and 13 policemen will be deployed in each centre. Besides, mobile police teams and striking forces will also be deployed to maintain the law and order during re-election.
