Call for gender equity in political parties

Speakers at a lecture series yesterday said gender equity inside political parties is a must to create a level-playing field for women leaders in the country.

However, most political parties do not even have enough women representation in their central committees, putting a barrier to women playing the role of decision-makers, they added.

The parties are also reluctant

to nominate more women or provide sufficient election fund for women candidates, they said that at the lecture series on 'Leveling the playing field for women leaders' jointly hosted by Bangladesh Alliance for Women Leadership and National Democratic Institute at a city hotel.

Dr Lesley Clark, former lawmaker of Queensland Parliament, Australia, was present as the keynote speaker.

Chairperson of the alliance

barrister Rabeya Bhuiyan, Executive Director Ambassador Nasim Firdaus, lawmakers Dr Shirin Sharmin and Tarana Halima and Prof Dilara Chowdhury of Jahangirnagar University spoke at the programme.

Sharing her experience in parliament, Lesley said, "Women can make a difference. To do that, you have to have power and become a leader at first. Changing rules inside your own party is important for that."

She stressed the need to nominate more women candidates by political parties and forming partnership with male members of the parties.

Currently, Bangladesh has record 64 women lawmakers. A total of 19 were elected through direct voting among them, while the others were selected for reserved seats.

Nasim Firdaus said, "There is a negative attitude towards women as leaders in society. Mindset change is needed. Women must also change their own views."



Money changer shot dead by muggers in city

A money changer who was shot on Wednesday night at Gulshan succumbed to his injuries at the National Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases in the city yesterday.

The victim identified as

Faruk Ahmed Khan, 48, was shot by a gang of muggers at Gulshan while he was returning to his residence Joar Sahara from his office along with his business partner and his car driver in a rickshaw. His car driver Anisur Rahman Ran was also shot and is now under treatment at the United Hospital in the city.

The muggers left the place leaving the car and pistols used during mugging, he said quoting the driver.

Gulshan police said they are trying to identify the owner of the car.

Faruk's younger brother Obaid Khan filed a case with the Gulshan police station in this connection.

Meanwhile Badda police recovered the body of a youth from South Anandagar of Badda area in the city on Wednesday night.

The youth was identified as Shipon Sikder.

His brother Ripon Sikder said some unknown persons took Shipon to an unknown place forcefully from his residence at Merul Badda.

Locals said Shipon was a source of Rapid Action Battalion (Rab).
