Robber killed in gunfight

An alleged robber was killed in a gunfight with police at village Suchakradandy under Patiya upazila yesterday. Locals said a group of 40 to 50 robbers entered the house of Abu Taher, manager of Agrani Bank Sarfatali branch under Boalkhali upazila, at around 3.30am and looted four tolas of gold ornament and Tk 20,000. As police encircled the area the robbers opened fire to flee the scene. Police chased them and opened fire. During a half-an-hour gunfight a robber sustained bullet injury and died at nearby Dhalghat Railway Station while the rest managed to flee. A single-barrel gun, three bullets and a wristwatch were recovered from the spot, Patiya police said.

Human chain at Rangpur

Rangpur Nagarik Committee organised a human chain in front of the local press club demanding restart of higher secondary certificate (HSC) courses at Rangpur Carmichael College. The demand for restart of HSC courses in the college was raised as all existing colleges in the town do not have the capacity to accommodate the increasing number of students. The education ministry dropped HSC courses at the college from 1995 on the plea of shortage of teachers, staff and seat problem.

Stolen railway sleepers seized

Rapid Action Battalion (Rab) on Monday seized 275 pieces of stolen railway sleepers from Ruppur and arrested one in connection with the theft. Rab raided the spot and seized a sleeper-laden truck. The arrestee, Arshed Ali, 26, is son of Afaz Uddin Pramanik of village Ghoshpur in Pabna Sadar upazila.

One gets life for murder

A trial court on Monday awarded a young man life term for killing his sister-in-law. Convict Mokon Miah of village Fatehpur of Gowanighat upazila is still at large. According to the prosecution story, when Mokon was beating his nephew Jasim Uddin over a trifling matter, Jasim's mother tried to prevent him. Mokon became furious and swooped on pregnant Saira Khatun who succumbed to injuries the next day. Mokon fled away. Saira's brother Shamsuddin filed a case in September 1997. Police on investigation filed charge-sheet on December 27 the same year against the accused. At least 10 witnesses gave their deposition.

Transport workers block road

Truck drivers and helpers jointly put up a barricade on road to Lalmonirhat-Burimari land port for two hours protesting extortion at Lalmonirhat bus terminal yesterday. The protesters withdrew the programme after police assured them of taking necessary steps against the illegal toll collectors at different points of roads in the district. During the blockade, two truck drivers and three helpers were injured as rival transport workers attacked the agitating group. Quoting truck drivers, police said a group of so-called transport workers with the help of ruling party men have been collecting illegal toll with fake chalan book from the truck drivers at eight points from Burimari land port to Teesta Railway Bridge in the district. The musclemen of ruling party also harass mentally or physically those who refuse to pay illegal toll, police said.

Life term for wife murder

A court here yesterday sentenced one person for life for killing wife. Shahadat Hossain, 30, was also fined Tk 5,000, in default, to suffer six months more in jail. The convict hails from village Taltala under Kalihati upazila. According to prosecution story, Shahadat strangled his wife Amena Begum, 30, at their house on March 29, 2007 over a family feud. Amena's father Yousuf Ali of village Bhurunga under Nalitabari upazila in Sherpur filed a murder case with Kalihati Police Station.

JANAJUDDHA CADRES REGROUP IN JHENIDAH Murders, bombings by outlaws yet to let up

Despite several anti-crime drives in the district there is no sign of any let up in killings and bomb attacks by the cadres of the Janajuddha faction of the outlawed Purba Banglar Communist Party (PBCP).

Sources said outlawed parties have regrouped in Jhenidah Sadar upazila. Cadres openly move with arms in areas like Ganna Bazaar, Chandipur Bazar, Kutu Durgapur Bazar, Shoilmari Bazar and Pagla Kanai Road. They extort businessmen, contractors and other wealthy people residing in these areas.

According to police and newspaper reports, at least 20 people were killed and five times bombs were exploded in the district in the last five months.

In a recent incident on May 26, an outlaw's body was recovered from a field at village Hengerpara under Harinakundo upazila.

Officer-in-charge (OC) Jahangir Alam of Harinakundo Police Station said, Asadul Islam Asha, 35, was a PBCP cadre. Son of Sadek Ali of village Bherakhali, he was a carpenter by profession. He might have been killed by his rival group over the murder of notorious Janajuddha cadre Heba Tagor on April 2, he said.

SI Nazrul Islam said, Asha suddenly went missing and his body was recovered after four days.

On May 20, the outlaws hacked to death Thandu Munshi, son of Nasiruddin of village Teltupi at a field at village Rahimpur of Harinakundo upazila.

On April 28, Janajuddha cadre Siddiqueer Rahman alias Biplob of village Defol Baria was killed in an encounter with police.

On April 27, Enamul of Suti Durgapur village under Sadar upazila was slaughtered to death at village Jalalpur in Kotchandpur upazila.

On April 23, the outlaws killed villager Rahit Kumar and looted all of his valuables from his house.

On April 16, Abdul Gani was bombed to death by criminals at village Mirzapur under Jhenidah Sadar upazila.

On April 15, two AL activists Azim Munsif and Kafil Uddin were murdered in a clash at village Bittidebi Rajnagar under Shaikupa upazila.

On April 9, Tahaj Uddin Topu was hacked to death by outlaws at village Bhaina under Harinakundo upazila.

On April 7, Ezahar Ali of village Brahmmapur under Shaikupa upazila was killed in a wheat field.

On April 4, Hadu Mondol was murdered at village Singia under Kotchandpur upazila.

On April 2, Shahidul Islam alias Heba Tagor was murdered by criminals at village Bherakhali under Harinakundo upazila.

On March 26, Amena Begum and Beauty Khatun were strangled in Jhenidah Sadar.

On March 23, Harun-or-Rashid of Moheshpur upazila was killed by an outlawed party gang.

On March 20, police killed an outlaw Tater of village Putimari under Shaikupa upazila. On the same day, regional PBCP leader Shamsel Robin was also shot dead by police at Kotchandpur bus stand.

On March 4, Sukumar Halder of village Rishkhali under Harinakundo upazila was hacked to death. The same day, Golam Kibria of Ashwasthali village was bombed to death by rival outlaws.

Contacted, Additional Superintendent of Police Zobaer Hossain admitted that killings in Jhenidah have increased in the recent months. "We are planning a massive crackdown," he said adding that a drive was already on to curb criminal activities in the district.

Too meagre for repair of damaged embankments

The government has allocated only 2,000 tonnes of rice worth about Tk 4 crore for repair of 284-km flood control embankment damaged by cyclone Aila in Patuakhali district against the demand for Tk 51 crore by Water Development Board (WDB).

"We had earlier sent several letters to the authorities concerned demanding Tk 51 crore. The allocation is too poor to meet the need. We have again sought more allocation to repair the damaged embankment," said Md Jahir Uddin, executive engineer of Patuakhali WDB.

Meanwhile, cyclone Aila washed away fish and shrimp in enclosures and hatcheries

in Shyamnagar, Assassuni, Kaliganj, Tala and Debhata upazilas under Satkhira district.

Of the embankment, 48.36km was damaged fully while 236.36km partially in seven upazilas of Patuakhali, according to our correspondent.

WDB sources said the storm damaged 15,236 km embankment fully and 70,86km partly in Galachipa upazila, 8.28km fully and 51 km partly in Kalapara upazila, 2.66 km fully and 32 km partly in Sadar upazila, 7km fully and 15.50 km partly in Mirzagonj upazila, 7.76km fully and 30.80km partly in Dumki upazila.

Sources in Satkhira district fisheries department said the May 25 cyclone washed away

about 7118 shrimp enclosures on 26,030 hectares of land and 4031 ponds on 428 hectares of land in the district, reports our correspondent.

According to preliminary estimate, shrimp worth about Tk 93.21 crore from enclosures, fish worth about Tk 26.72 crore from ponds and fish fries worth about Tk 3.90 crore from hatcheries were washed away.

District fisheries department officials said the loss incurred by cyclone Aila in coastal upazilas in the district will cast an adverse impact on shrimp exports and also on fish supply to the markets.

Sources said fishing inputs, including nets and boats, worth about Tk 39.39 crore were also damaged by the twister.

57 BDR MUTINEERS IN SYLHET Charge-framing now on July 12

A Sylhet court yesterday deferred charge-framing against 57 BDR personnel in a sedition case to July 12.

District and Sessions Judge Md Momin Ullah fixed the date as public prosecutor prayed for time extension. The judge also fixed the same date for hearing the bail petitions of the accused, court sources said.

All the 57 BDR men of 38 Battalion, accused of staging mutiny at their battalion headquarters in Sylhet following Pilkhana 'revolt', were produced in the court.

Public Prosecutor Misbahuddin Siraj said, "We have sought time for preparing the records of the sensational case so that charges against the accused can be framed rightly".

Earlier, the chief judicial magistrate had sent the case records of two sedition cases--one against 57 and the other against 51--to the district and

sessions judge to start trial process.

Officer-in-charge (OC) of Sylhet Kotwali Police Station Syeduzzaman filed three sedition cases with the Chief Judicial Magistrate Court on 17 May against 142 BDR men of Sylhet Sector Headquarters and two battalions. Of them, 51 are from 21 Battalion, 57 from 38 Battalion and the rest from Sector Headquarters.

Jubo League, BCL clash over tender dropping

Two leaders of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) were injured in a clash between activists of BCL and Jubo League over dropping of tender documents at Barisal Public Works Department (PWD) office yesterday.

The injured are Faisal bin Islam, former cultural affairs secretary of BM College unit of BCL, and Dinar, an activist of city BCL.

Jubo League activists led by Dipu, Abdullah, Rezvi and Dollar and BCL men led by Faisal and Dinar took positions at Barisal PWD office for submission of tender papers for constructing tahsil offices (land offices) in Babuganj, Banaripara, and Muladi upazilas of the district, witnesses said.

Yesterday was the closing date for submission of the Tk 60 lakh tender.

Both the groups tried to control tender submission and prevent the 'opponents' from dropping tender documents without negotiation.

As the BCL men led by Faisal tried to drop tender at about 12:30pm, the Jubo League men interfered, beat up Faisal and Dinar and made them leave PWD office premises without dropping tender, said witnesses.

8 more sued for war crime

Eight alleged collaborators of Pakistan occupation forces were sued on Monday on charge of murdering a freedom fighter during liberation war in 1971.

The case was filed with the court of Senior Judicial magistrate Begum Rozina Akther by Shukhjan Begum, wife of slain freedom fighter Mahatab Biswas of village Garhkhola under Dakope upazila.

The complainant stated in her petition that

the accused on August 10, 1971 picked up Mahatab from his house and hacked him to death at Garhkhola rajakar camp after physical torture the next day.

The eight accused are Nausher Sheikh, Zahur Sheikh, Mahub Molla, Hamajuddin, Shaif Gazi, Asmat Gazi, Elahi Sana and Moni Sana. All of them are alive.

The court asked the officer-in-charge of Dakope Police Station to submit a report after investigation into the allegation by July 29.
