

Nachole grabbers eye land of 17 indigenous families

Indigenous people yesterday formed human chain and held rally in Nachole bus stand area demanding punishment to the hired goons of the land grabbers who tried to occupy land of 17 indigenous families at Dulahar village in Nachole upazila of the district on Thursday.

The attackers seriously injured two indigenous women and threatened with dire consequences if the 17 indigenous families did not vacate the khas land, the indigenous leaders said at the rally organised by Nachole Adivasi Adhikar Kendra and residents of Dulahar village.

Meanwhile, police arrested two persons in connection with Thursday's attack on indigenous people.

Belasius Murmu, president of Nachole Adivasi Academy, Hingu Murmu, president of Uttar Banga Adivasi Forum, Bisut Moni Toppo, central leader of Jatiya Adivasi Parishad, Prohlad Mahdi,

member of upazila Adivasi Samannay Parishad, spoke at yesterday's rally.

They demanded security of the local indigenous people.

Earlier on Sunday, indigenous people observed protest programmes in Rajshahi,

Naogaon and Magura demanding punishment to the perpetrators who evicted 74 indigenous families from their lands at Khatirpur under Porsha upazila of Naogaon district on June 13.

They also demanded immediate steps for rehabilitation of the evicted families.

Indigenous leaders had also urged the government to form a separate land commission for indigenous communities and ensure their constitutional rights.

45 Ansar men sued on charge of torturing people

A torture victim yesterday filed a case against five Ansar members including an acting battalion commanding officer and 40 other unnamed Ansar men on charge of beating up local people including women and children.

The accused are Nurul Afzar Chowdhury, acting commanding officer of 27 Ansar Battalion of Sathkira, Habildar Shah Jahan Mridha, sepoy Atiar Rahman, Asaduzzaman and Shah Jalal, and 40 others of the battalion.

A group of Ansar members began to tease the local women when they were bathing in a pond near the Ansar battalion headquarters at Puratan Sathkira on Sunday noon, complainant Rafiqul Hasan, a resident of Puratan Sathkira in the town, said in the case filed with Sadar Police Station.

As the locals tried to prevent the Ansar men from the offensive act, the latter became furious and attacked

them.

The Ansar men beat up the inmates of nearby houses, leaving at least 15 people including women and children injured, and vandalised a few houses, he said.

As Rafiqul Hasan strongly protested Ansar men's inhuman activities, they took him to their headquarters and tortured him to serious injuries, he said. Later police rescued him.

Despite repeated attempts, this correspondent failed to contact with acting Battalion Commanding Officer Nurul Afzar Chowdhury for his comment as his cell phone was switched off.

On contact, Sadar Police Station Officer-in-Charge Kamruzzaman said lawful action will be taken against the perpetrators after investigation.

Protesting the incident and demanding arrest and punishment to the responsible Ansar members, local people held a press conference in a restaurant in the town yesterday.

Bogra tops list of acid attack

At least 123 people in Bogra district were acid-burnt as the country's highest 120 incidents of acid attack took place there from 1998 to April 2009 while the second highest 117 incidents were recorded in Sirajganj district.

Acid Survivors Foundation (ASF) sources revealed the information in a meeting jointly organised by Bogra-

based NGO Light House and ASF at Bogra Deputy Commissioner's Office auditorium on Wednesday.

The meeting was informed that a total of 2809 people had been burnt in the country from 1998 to April 2009 including 1406 women and 709 children below the 18 years.

According to the ASF survey most of the acid throwing cases followed rejection of love and land dispute while easy availability of sulfuric

acid helped the criminals.

Most of the acid victims were later threatened by the accused and many cases were 'settled' following pressure from local influential people, speakers said at the meeting.

Aishaha, her mother Hasina and relative Shamima were acid-burnt on October 4 in 2007 following 'rejection of love' but justice eluded them as the case was 'settled' due to pressure from the accused and law enforcers.

Local journalists told the meeting that more than 600 traders are using acid without any licenses for jewellery business. Besides, a large number of traders are selling acid in the district without licenses.

Additional Deputy Commissioner (ADC - General) Ayub Hossain presided over the meeting and ADC (Education and Development) Swapon Kamur Ghosh attended it as chief guest.

Ex-MP held on charge of war crime

Police on Sunday night arrested former lawmaker Moulana Sakhawat Hossain, president member of Jatiya Party (Ershad) from his residence in Keshobpur upazila in connection with 1971 war crimes. He was produced in court yesterday. The court rejected both the bail and remand prayers and sent him to Jessore Central Jail.

A team of DB police arrested Sakhawat following a case filed by one Sazzad Ali Mollah on June 21 accusing him of killing his father. According to the case, on November 24 in 1971, Sakhawat and his accomplices attacked the house of Khidir Mollah of village Boruli under Keshobpur upazila. They shot Khidir Mollah dead and set his house on fire.

BNP men in 2 dists threaten to resign

Aggrieved BNP men in Sathkira and Khulna have threatened to resign en masse and launch agitation programme if their demand for changes in the newly formed convening committees of the two district units are not met within the deadline given earlier.

Leaders and activists of Sathkira district units of BNP front organisation gave a 72-hour deadline on Sunday to meet their demand for removal of former BIP lawmaker Kazi Alauddin and former district BNP general secretary Kamrul Islam Farooque from the newly formed convening committee, according to our correspondent.

They alleged that the central committee made the two controversial persons joint convenors of the convening committee, ignoring opinions of the grassroots leaders and activists of the party and its front organisations.

The leaders and activists of the front organisations urged the BNP chairperson to remove Alauddin and Farooque from the new convening committee within the next 72 hours, otherwise they threatened to launch an agitation programme.

The demand was made at a press conference in the town. District Sramik Dal President

Abdus Samad read out a written statement at the conference.

Our staff correspondent from Khulna reports: A new crisis has developed in Khulna BNP as the deadline given by the leaders and activists to revive the 12-member convening committee ended yesterday.

In a closed-door meeting on Thursday night, 24 leaders over 100 activists of the district unit gave an ultimatum to Chairperson Khaleda Zia to revive the convening committee with Rupsha unit President Monir, Ahmed Bana, and Dakop unit President Apurbo Kumar as joint convenors by June 22, otherwise they threatened to resign en masse.

The central committee on June 17 dropped the names of the two leaders from the new convening committee declared on June 9 as a faction of the district unit demanded removal of the two, alleging their controversial role during the caretaker government's rule.

The leaders and activists said they will resign any day as the party high command did not pay heed to their demand within the deadline.

They also demanded expulsion of Shafiqul Alam Mona, one of the 11 joint convenors of the new convening committee, for 'hatching' conspiracy against the party leaders and inclusion of five more leaders in the committee.

Two to die for killing

A Bogra court yesterday awarded death sentence to two persons for killing one Ismail at village Iorpurkura under Adamdighi upazila about 10 years ago. The convicts are Abdul Majid Khoka and Abdul Rahman. Five other accused Faruk, Asadul, Moju, Bhola and Sutka got life term and were fined Tk 50,000 each. Twelve others were acquitted of the charges. According to prosecution story, farmer Ismail's hey stack was set afire on December 24, 1999. Ismail went to the local chairman for justice. When he was returning home early morning a criminal gang attacked him. Ismail died on January 3, 2000 while undergoing treatment at a hospital. Ismail's son Ishaque Ali filed a case with Adamdighi police station on December 25, 1999 accusing 19 people.

Businessman murdered

A Jubo League activist and businessman was murdered in Bhabaniganj area in the town Sunday night allegedly over trade dispute. Bangladesh Engineering Industries owners' Association Natore unit yesterday observed strike demanding punishment to the killers. Shops kept their shutters down, a human chain was formed followed by a silent procession that paraded the town. Victim Sahidullah, 25, was son of Liakat Ali of village South Patuapara in Natore town. Police and witnesses said, Sahidullah was called out of his house at 10pm on Sunday. Later, he was taken to Bhabaniganj area and stabbed to death. Being informed, police raided the house of one Jewel and recovered a mobile set of Sahidullah. SI Nuruzzaman of Natore police station said, Sahidullah might have been killed over some business enmity.

PCJSS leader shot

A leader of Parbattya Chattagram Jana Sanghati Samity (PCJSS) was shot by an armed gang at Balukhali union on Sunday night. Police and locals said an armed gang of 15 led by Tito Chakma and Biro Chakma, encircled the house of Chironjit Chakma. The gang was looking for Aungsu Moni Chakma and Asheen Chakma -- local PCJSS leader and former Pahari Chhatra Parishad (PCP) leader there. The armed men opened fire when both of them were fleeing sensing the presence of their rivals. Asheen was unhurt but Aungsu Moni Chakma received severe bullet injuries. Md Humayun, officer-in-charge of Kotwali police confirmed the incident. He, however, said no case was filed in this connection.

Stone trader murdered

Panchagarh police yesterday recovered the body of a stone trader from the bordering Shaw River. Victim Moshirul Haque, 32, hailed from village Murkhagachh of Tetulia upazila. Family sources said that Moshirul had been missing since Sunday. Police could not ascertain the reason for his death. But sources said Moshirul's body bore some marks of injury. Nasirul Haque, younger brother of the victim filed a murder case with Tetulia police station yesterday.

Father, 6 sons get life

A Habiganj court yesterday awarded six brothers and their father life term for killing. The convicts are Abdul Mannan of village Khagaura under Sadar upazila and his six sons, of whom Golap Miah and Hason Miah are absconding. According to prosecution story, one Sheju Miah, son of Akku Miah of the same village was killed by the accused on November 12 of 2000 as a sequel to previous enmity. Victim's uncle Tokai Miah filed a case accusing eight persons Abdul Mannan, his wife Khototi Bibi and six sons. Mannan's wife died during trial of the case.

2 Janajuddho cadres arrested

Two cadres of Janajuddho faction of the outlawed PBCP were arrested yesterday from Banishanta red light area under Dakope upazila. Police said, Rubel and Kamrul, the outlaws, had demanded Tk2 lakh from Banishanta UP member Abdus Salam on Sunday threatening to kill him for non-payment. The arrested outlaws are undergoing treatment in Dakope Upazila Health Complex as they were beaten by police after arrest. The outlaws were wanted in several criminal cases including murders filed with Dakope police station, OC Ziauzzaman said.
