

# Ustad Ali Akbar Khan: A sarod maestro departs

My uncle Ustad Ali Akbar Khan, the unparalleled sarod maestro, died recently. His father Ustad Alauddin Khan and my grandfather Ustad Ayet Ali Khan were brothers.

The news came as a shock, though he had crossed the ripe old age of 87. On June 19, Doordarshan formally conveyed the news of his sad demise.

What a glorious musical career he had enjoyed! It was a saga of arduous rewaz, going up to as much as 18 hours a day.

Born in the village of Shibpur in Brahmanbaria, Bangladesh, Ustad Ali Akbar Khan grew up in Maihar, Ayet Ali Khan. Madhya Pradesh, where his father was the court musician to the Maharaja. An early entrant to the world of music, he began vocal training at the tender age of three. He then went on to practice diverse musical instruments under the tutelage of his father, who was adept at 200 instruments. However when the young boy reached the age of nine, his father decided that he should specialise in the sarod. In 1933, at the age of 11, he began to play a sarod especially designed

Ustad Ali Akbar Khan had many credits to his name, having bagged the President of India Award twice over, and as a recipient of the Padma Bhushan and Padma Vibhushan. In the United States, he was invited to play at the inaugural ceremonies of President Kennedy and, in 1991, he received the MacArthur Foundation Genius Fellowship in recognition of his work in transmitting and enhancing the musical tradition of North India. In 1993 he received the Bill Graham Lifetime Achievement Award. From 1970 to 1998 he was nominated for the Grammy Award five times. But due to some technical hitches he declined the nomination. In 1994 the Ali Akbar Foundation was set up to archive and preserve

# Abu Sayeed's next venture Apekkha to zoom in on terrorism

Every time director Abu Sayeed has undertaken a feature film project, the subject has been thought provoking. Be it "Nirontor," "Shankhonad," "Banshi" or "Rupantor."

But when he makes his fifth film next year, he might face a different kind of challenge as the subject is going to be terrorism.

After a three-year hiatus since "Rupantor" (2007), the internationally-acclaimed director returns to feature filmmaking next year with the work tentatively titled "Apekkha".

Sayeed told The Daily Star that the script for the proposed film has been written by him and revolves round the story of two youths in contrasting circumstances -- one a terrorist and another who is killed by terrorists -- and their families.

The common thread running through the two families is the absence of the youths from daily life -- a father pining away for his terrorist son who is lost to the family while a grandmother mourning the death of his grandson killed by an act of terrorism, Sayeed said.

Referring to the title of the film, Sayeed says both the father of the terrorist and the grandmother of the terror victim are waiting for their dear ones to return; both have been lost to terrorism.

Sayeed feels terrorism being a global issue. his next film is set to appeal to a much wider audience than his previous film "Rupantor" (Transformation), which was adjudged the best international entry at the International Film Festival on Tribal Art and Culture in Bhopal recently.

The accolade for his earlier feature film "Nirontor," which won three awards at different international festivals in India four years ago, inspired him to make the next feature film "Banshi" (Flute). The success of "Rupantor" in the Bhopal festival has inspired Sayeed to return to feature film once his present assignment of making a TV serial is over.

"Award does give you inspiration and it also helps in your area of activity," says Sayeed.

The director is yet to finalise the cast of "Apekkha" but would like to start work on it once he completes the TV serial "Pashapashi."
