

Israeli defense minister, US envoy meet in New York

US envoy George Mitchell held low-key talks here yesterday with Israeli Defense Minister Ehud Barak as Washington seeks to breathe new life into the ailing Middle East peace talks.

The meeting began around 1205 GMT at the Hotel Intercontinental in Manhattan, and kicked off with a photo call for news photographers.

But the two men refused to answer any questions, except when Barak was asked if he was optimistic about the talks as he was smiling.

"It means a smile doesn't cost too much," Barak shot back. "We are naturally positive, every day."

Ties between Israel and its major ally the United States have strained in recent weeks over the US administration's insistence that the Jewish state must halt settlement building in the West Bank.

On Monday the State Department said it was not ruling out the possibility of a compromise with Israel on a settlement freeze, amid reports that Israel might be ready to agree to stall settlement construction for three months.

"We've been working with all the parties to try and come up with... an environment conducive to the resumption of negotiations," said State Department spokesman Ian Kelly.

"And we look forward to sitting down and talking about what we can do to move this process forward," he added.

But he added: "I'm not going to prejudice what happens tomorrow (Tuesday)."

The New York Times first reported news of a possible settlement freeze on Monday, citing Israeli officials who spoke on condition of anonymity.

The newspaper said the freeze could last three to six months and would be presented as a proposal by Barak during his talks Tuesday with Mitchell.

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, who accepted the idea of a Palestinian state for the first time during a mid-June address, has refused to stop settlement construction.

And according to the Israeli daily Yediot Aharonot, the three-month freeze envisioned by Netanyahu would not include the thousands of buildings already under construction in many settlements, nor new building in East Jerusalem.

1.10 in 2008 from minus 1.08 in 2007. As regards political stability and absence of violence and terrorism, Bangladesh improved to minus 1.54 in 2008 from minus 1.40 in 2007 and in case of voice and accountability, its status improved slightly -- minus 0.61 in 2008 from minus 0.59 in 2007.

In the worsening side, regulatory quality stood at minus 0.82 in 2008 compared to minus 0.86 in 2007, the rule of law at minus 0.70 in 2008 against minus 0.77 in 2007, and government effectiveness stood at minus 0.77 in 2008 compared to minus 0.80 in 2007, according to the WGI.

Zaid Bakht said the real picture would emerge from the situation in 2009 as the caretaker government was installed for a short period.

He mentioned that in 2008 the caretaker government focused its attention to the national election. As a result, it could not give much attention to administration. Implementation of the annual development programme (ADP) was also the lowest during the period.

As a result, Bangladesh's performance in government effectiveness showed poorly in the WB indicator.

The BIDS research director said earning confidence of all parties, the caretaker government succeeded in bringing them in the electoral fray.

During its tenure, crime level was low, political and other types of agitation were rare, resulting in better political stability and fall in violence.

Zaid also said due to the anti-corruption drive during the caretaker government's rule, businesses could not function properly for fear arrests on graft charges.

Contacted, WB senior economist at its Dhaka office Zahid Hussain said good governance is a key priority for the bank. "We are supporting the government's efforts in a number of areas such as public financial management, and power, health and education sectors."

The WGI is prepared as part of a larger effort to study the consequences of governance for development, and its usefulness should be looked at in this broader context, he said.

Resource allocation by the WB group is based on a country's performance and need, and not on these indicators, Zahid noted.

The indicators reflect information gathered from a variety of sources, the WB senior economist said. "They measure a country's percentile rank with respect to each indicator. Percentile rank indicates the percentage of countries worldwide that rate below the selected country."

Qaeda warns France of revenge for burka stance

Al-Qaeda's North Africa wing threatened on Tuesday to take revenge on France for its opposition to the burka, calling on Muslims to retaliate against the country, the US monitoring service SITE Intelligence reported.

President Nicolas Sarkozy had said earlier this month that the burka, which covers the whole face, was not welcome in the strictly secular country.

"Yesterday was the hijab (the Islamic headscarf long banned in French schools) and today, it is the niqab (the full veil)," the leader of Al-Qaeda in the Islamic Maghreb Abu Musab Abdul Wadud was quoted as saying.

"We will take revenge for the honour of our daughters and sisters against France and against its interests by every means at our disposal."

The group also called on Muslims to retaliate for what it called French "hostility" against the community and its attempt to obstruct Islam's practice on its territory.

"For us, the mujahedeen... we will not remain silent to such provocations and injustices," Abdul Wadud said without elaborating, according to SITE.

"We call upon all Muslims to confront this hostility with greater hostility, and to counter France's efforts to divide male and female believers from their faith with a greater effort... (by) adherence to the teachings of their Islamic sharia."

He said Muslims in France, who are estimated at around five million, are "increasingly concerned about the practices of French politicians and leaders and their harassment."

On June 22, Sarkozy said the burka was not a symbol of religious faith but a sign of women's "subservience," adding that the head-to-toe veil was "not welcome" in staunchly secular France.

their cars at the parking lot of Sadharan Bima Corporation.

"But DCC is charging less for street parking encouraging people to park their cars on the street rather than the multi-storey parking facility meant to be used for parking," he said, adding that this will not help ease the traffic jam in the area.

General manager of Sadharan Bima Corporation ARM Khalequzzaman said the parking space at the Sadharan Bima was constructed as per a decision of the BNP government during its tenure in 2006.

"We could have earned three times more if we had constructed offices in place of the parking space but we did it for the sake of easing the traffic gridlock in the area. We are not getting the proper response from vehicle owners due to lack of support from the law enforcers," he said.

He said the recent decision of DCC has further reduced around 20 percent vehicles at our parking space, which are now being parked on the road.

"We have issued a letter requesting DCC to change the decision as this kind of parking will encourage people to park their cars on the road," he said.

"We earn Tk 2.25 lakh every month which can go up to Tk 9 lakh if the parking space is filled to its full capacity," he added.

"We also sent a letter to IGP two months back and after that traffic police conducted a drive there which helped us to get around 100 more cars," he continued.

Riday Hossain, an employee of Nawal, said they had been collecting toll since June 15.

Joint Commissioner of traffic Manzur Kader Khan said parking on the road causes serious traffic congestion in the area.

Jasim, a driver of a private car who parked his car on the road just in front of the parking lot, said as his master is not willing to keep his car at the parking space at Sadharan Bima he parks it on the road everyday.

Another driver of a private car Shafiq who also parks on the road from 9:30 am to 1:30 pm everyday said he has nothing to do, as it is the decision of his master to park on the road.

Chief Town Planner of DCC Md Sirajul Islam said they suspended parking on the street after the inauguration of Sadharan Bima Corporation parking facility.

As a huge portion of the parking lot remains empty and cars are parked on the street in front of the specified parking space of Sadharan Bima they allowed parking on the streets, he said.

Siraj said they had assigned a firm to bring the vehicles under a systematic parking and improve the worsening traffic congestion in the area.

Parking on the street will be stopped after the completion of two under-construction parking lots -- City Centre and another one at Dilkusha just beside the Sadharan Bima Parking facility, he said.

"We have allowed parking at those places where it will not hamper the traffic movement," he said.

Siraj said they had sent a letter to DMP asking suggestion of parking on the streets before giving the permission but they did not get any reply.

"We are open to any suggestion to ease traffic chaos in the area in future," he added.

US court delays decision on death row inmate

The US Supreme Court has quietly put off deciding whether it will take up the case of black death row inmate Troy Davis who for 20 years has insisted he did not kill a white policeman, a source close to Davis said yesterday.

"The US Supreme Court called Troy's lawyer -- there will be no decision (which also means no execution date) until their court reconvenes in September," Sara Totonchi, head of Georgians for Alternatives to the Death Penalty, which supports Davis, said in an email sent to AFP.

Davis's lawyer was not available for comment.

The justices delayed a decision in Davis's case without explanation on Monday, the last day of the Supreme Court's term before a long summer recess.

Davis has been in jail for 18 years for the murder in 1989 of white police officer Mark Allen MacPhail.

Now 41, Davis has repeatedly said he did not kill MacPhail, and seven out of nine witnesses who gave evidence at his trial in 1991 have recanted or changed their testimony.

No murder weapon was ever found, no DNA evidence or fingerprints tie him to the crime, which other witnesses have since said was committed by another man -- a state's witness who testified against Davis.

Davis has won several 11-hour stays of execution since July 2007, when he was originally sentenced to die for murdering MacPhail.

One of the stays was granted by the Supreme Court in September last year, less than two hours before Davis was due to be put to death.

Around two weeks later, the high court refused to consider the constitutionality of executing a person when there is new evidence to show he was not guilty of the crime he stands accused of, and referred Davis's

case back to the lower courts.

In April, a court in Georgia denied Davis a retrial but granted him another stay of execution to allow lawyers to take his case back to the Supreme Court.

With its racial overtones and Davis's continued claims of innocence, the case has triggered an international outcry, including from the European Union, whose 27 member states oppose any use of capital punishment, Nobel Peace Prize winner Desmond Tutu of South Africa, and Pope Benedict XVI.

Scientists bid adieu to plucky solar probe

US and European scientists were yesterday bidding farewell to the tenacious solar probe Ulysses which has been recording data around the sun for more than 18 years, four times longer than planned.

"Ulysses has taught us more than we ever expected about the sun and the way it interacts with the space surrounding it," said Richard Marsden, Ulysses project manager with the European Space Agency (ESA).

ESA and the US space agency were planning to send their final radio communication to the lonely Ulysses at 1535 GMT, and then pull the plug on the probe as it floats further and further away from Earth.

Since its launch into space in October 1990, Ulysses, named after the king of Ithaca in Greek mythology, has scanned the far reaches of the sun on a journey which has taken it some nine billion kilometers (5.5 billion miles).

One of its discoveries was that the magnetic fields of the sun spread their influence across the whole solar system, something that had previously not been known.

a knock-out stench of burning kerosene around me. I realised my body was on fire," Momtaj said.

Her husband's family had poured kerosene on her and set her on fire.

Shamsul and his family stood by and watched as Momtaj screamed for mercy. Neighbours rushed to her help. They doused the fire and tried homemade remedies to soothe her burns.

Her parents, who live in another upazila, were informed and they rushed her to the nearby Jessore Sadar Hospital where she underwent preliminary treatment.

She had suffered severe burns to 37 percent of her body. She was later shifted to the DMCH Burn Unit on June 18, when her condition deteriorated.

This week Momtaj is no longer around to complain about the brutality that was her life.

Momtaj's mother, Shahnaz, told The Daily Star that after Momtaj underwent a bypass surgery last year, doctors told her not to carry out any work that involved lifting of heavy objects. She has also been weak since the operation. She was thus not able to work around the house as much as she used to before.

Shamsul then demanded Tk one lakh from her father, which he described as 'compensation' for Momtaj's illness.

Her father Rabiul Islam, a farmer, had already paid Tk 1.5 lakh as a major portion of her bypass operation expenses. Despite that, Shamsul regularly beat up ailing Momtaj because her father had not yet paid the money.

"We are poor but we still gave Momtaj's husband furniture, gold jewellery and three oxen as dowry for the wedding," Shahnaz said.

She said her daughter returned home several times with severe injuries from her husband's beatings.

"But what could we do? We are too poor to look after her and her two children. So each time, we had to send her back to that monster," Shahnaz said as she broke down in tears.

Momtaj's brother Shimul Hossain has filed a case against Shamsul Biswas, his older brother Nurul Biswas, sister Anowara begum and his brother-in-law Abdul Hamid.

Not unusually, Shamsul has been absconding along with his family members since the incident.

No one has been arrested so far, officer-in-charge Abdul Kader of Kotwali Thana, Jessore, said yesterday.
