Speakers at the ceremony said the writer through her book has portrayed the natural beauty, lives and livelihood of the indigenous people, their festivity, rich culture and struggle.


They also said the forms and structures of Kanak's paintings had a spellbinding effect on the spectators while the theme of her paintings create scope for thinking.

## Jackson leaves estate

Michael Jackson's will has been filed in a Los Angeles court, giving his entire estate to a family trust.

The document, dated July 7, 2002, also reveals the star "intentionally omitted" to provide for his former wife, Debbie Rowe.

Jackson's mother, Katherine, is named as a beneficiary of the trust and the guardian of the singer's three young children, who are named in the will.

It estimated Jackson's estate at that time to be more than \$500m (£303m).

The Michael Jackson Family Trust would benefit his three children, his mother and unnamed charities, according to Reuters.

The news agency also reported that Jackson's fivepage will said: "I have intentionally omitted to provide for my former wife, Deborah Rowe Jackson."

Rowe married Jackson in 1996 but filed for divorce in 1999. She gave up custody rights to the children but Michael II - was born to a sought them again in 2003.
