

## 32 more sued in 3 districts for war crimes

### Former Jamaat lawmaker of Satkhira faces charges

Thirty-two alleged collaborators of Pakistani occupation forces have been sued for killing, arson and looting in Satkhira, Moulvibazar and Gopalganj in 1971.

In Satkhira, a petition case was filed with the Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court yesterday, accusing nine collaborators, including former Jamaat lawmaker Maulana Abdul Khaleque, of killing five innocent people in Sadar upazila during the Liberation War, according to our correspondent.

The eight other accused are Saifullah Sardar, Korban Ali and Abdul Karim of Shimulbaria village, Akkaj Ali and Baker Ali of Balitha village, Shahidul Islam of Kaliani village, Zafar Ali of Fingri village and Zahirul alias Tikka Khan of Baikari village under the upazila.

The complainant, Nazrul Islam Gazi of Shimulbaria village, in his case statement said the accused picked up his father Rustam Ali, Idris Ali, Babar Ali, Nur Ali and Momtaz Mollah of the village on May 20, 1971, took them to Ellarchar area and shot them dead.

Our Moulvibazar correspondent adds: A case was filed with Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate's Court here on Wednesday against 16 people for their alleged

involvement in war crimes in Kamalganj area in 1971.

Mutaleb Miah of Barcheg village under Kamalganj upazila filed the case, accusing Anwar Khan, former chairman of Kamalganj Upazila Parishad, Advocate Misir Ullah of Syed Sikandar Ali Road in Moulvibazar town, Mannan Miah of Chandipur village under Kamalganj upazila and 13 unidentified people of killing innocent people and setting fire to their houses during the war.

Son of a martyred freedom fighter has filed a petition case with Gopalganj Judicial Magistrate's Court against seven 'rajakars' for killing his father during the Liberation War, reports a correspondent.

The plaintiff, Sultan Ahmed, in his case filed with the court on June 23 stated that rajakars Solomon Miah, Hares Sheikh, Chona Mia, Kheyal Uddin Mollah, Siddiqur Rahman and Moni Miah picked up his father Abdus Salam Miah at gunpoint from 'in front of Kashiani Ramdia Post Office, took him to Pak army camp in Gopalganj town and killed him.

Advocate Kazi Nazrul Islam, who stood for the petitioner, said the court took the case into cognisance and ordered Kashiani Police Station to take legal steps in this regard.

## HEAVY RAIN DISRUPTS LIFE IN CTG, SYLHET CITIES

# Flood in Khagrachhari, fresh areas in Netrakona inundated

Heavy downpour for the last 2-3 days coupled with onrush of hill water has triggered flash flood in several areas of Khagrachhari while floodwater has submerged more low-lying areas in Netrakona.

Heavy rain for the last three days disrupted life also in Chittagong city and submerged the low-lying areas.

Meanwhile, water-logging in Sylhet city and surrounding areas due to rain is causing immense sufferings to the townsfolk.

Our Khagrachhari Correspondent reports: Around 10 thousand people of Merung,

Merung Bazar, Bachha Merung, Hazachhara, Kobakhali, Betchhari and Chhoto Merung under Dighinala upazila have been marooned and road links in several areas snapped due to rain in the last couple of days.

Dighinala Upazila Administration sources said, the Malnee River overflowed due to onrush of hill water triggering flood in at least 25 villages. The helpless villagers have taken shelter in six temporary flood shelters with their domestic animals. Roads linking Dighinala and Merung and some other areas of the district have gone under water.

Our Correspondent from Netrakona says: Flood situa-

tion in Netrakona worsened further in the bordering areas of Durgapur and Kalmakanda while more low-lying areas of Kalmakanda, Mohanganj and Khalajuri upazilas went under water as heavy rainfall and onrush of hill water from across the border continued.

The newly affected areas are Barkapon, Chowhatta, Ranagoun, Majipara, Korlpara, Bariund, Gobindapur, Kashabpur, Kagaipara, Basirpasha and Baltali under Kalmakanda upazila. Many low-lying areas of Mohanganj and Khalajuri have also been submerged.

The 5 kilometre-long Gutara to Barkapon road in Kalmakanda upazila and 4-

kilometre Udoypur to Rika Bazar road have gone under water.

Erosion of the Ubdakhali River has also taken a serious turn as the river devoured about 50 dwelling houses of Kashobpur village.

Our CU Correspondent adds: Heavy rain for the third consecutive day yesterday disrupted normal life in the city and triggered a flood like situation at Lohagara and Mirsarai upazilas of the district.

Water-logging kept people of many areas of the city at home while the commuters experienced a serious gridlock at city's busy thoroughfares at Agrabad, Dewan Hat, Sholoshahar Gate No 2, Murad Pur and Bohoddar Hat intersections.

Local met office recorded a total of 57 mm rainfall in the last 24-hours ending at 3.00pm yesterday.

The downpour that started on Tuesday morning inundated the low-lying areas of Bakolia, Halishahar A block, H Block and I Block, Agrabad CDA Residential area, Bepari Para, Shanti Bag, Shaymali Residential area, Bohoddar Hat, Murad Pur, Shulok Bahar, Kapash Gola and Chavk Bazar.

However, water in most areas started receding after the rain ceased at 2:00pm and water-logging could not take a serious turn, thanks to the ongoing excavation and renovation of city canals.

Meanwhile, some areas under Lohagara upazila went under water where the Dalu River embankment developed breaches at some points. Low-lying areas under Mirsarai upazila also submerged due to onrush of hill water.

Our Staff Correspondent from Sylhet adds: Heavy rain yesterday paralysed the city life submerging many low-lying areas by noon.

Water logging in Sylhet city and its suburbs during the rainy season remains a nagging problem for the townsfolk.

Officials at Sylhet City Corporation (SCC) admitted that rainwater cannot pass through the drains and canals as those have been narrowed down by land grabbers and dumping of waste.

Roads at Bilopar, Kuarpur, Laladighirpar, Kanishail, Hawapara, Dargah mohalla, Kajolshah, Bagbari, Shahjalal Upashahar, Tero Ratan, Jatapur, Hosnabad, Jhalopara and Mendibag go under water even after a little rain.

A number of shopping malls and kitchen markets also face the same problem. Traders at the markets shut down their shops during the shower as the road in front of their markets become waterlogged.

## Man-eater beaten to death by villagers

Locals beat a Royal Bengal Tiger dead after it injured three people at Khalishabunia village under Shyamnagar upazila of Satkhira yesterday.

Police quoted villagers and forest officials as saying that the tiger entered the village crossing the river Kholpetua at around 6:00am and injured three villagers.

The injured—Sahiluddin, 60, Aziz, 50 and Abdul, 55—are now undergoing treatment at Shyamnagar Upazila Health Complex.

As the villagers along with forest guards chased the tiger, it took shelter on the roof of a thatched house at the village. The villagers and forest guards then cordoned off the house and informed the divisional forest office of the matter.

Being informed, Khulna Divisional Forest Officer (DFO) Abani Bhushan Thakur reached the spot and asked the forest guards to collect net to catch the man-eater. He also requested the villagers not to kill the tiger.

Ignoring the request, a group of local youths climbed the roof of the house at around 2:00pm and beat the tiger dead, local sources said.

Forest guards immediately arrested one of the youth named Maniruzzaman for killing the tiger. They later handed him over to the police.

When contacted, the divisional forest officer (DFO) said legal action will be taken against those who killed the tiger.

## 23 sex workers start life anew in Khulna

Christian Service Society (CSS), a non-governmental organisation (NGO), has provided 23 sex workers with jobs to encourage them to return to normal life.

The NGO has brought the sex workers under an eight-month training on matters relating to technical education and gave them certificates on completion of the training at a rehabilitation centre at Sonadanga in the city.

Mark Munshi, chief executive of CSS, told this correspondent last week that about eight months ago he invited sex workers at different brothels in Khulna city and district to join the programme if they want to discard the hateful profession. Twenty-three sex workers from different brothels quickly responded to the

move, Munshi added.

These women, who have started a new life, have been provided with jobs and given Tk 1,30,000 each for purchasing land and construction of their houses, the CSS chief executive said.

He further said the women won't be able to withdraw any amount from Tk 1,30,000 before one year as it has been deposited in fixed accounts opened in a bank against their names.

KCC Mayor Talukder Abdul Khaleq said CSS has set a unique example of how the sex workers can be brought to normal life.

"Hope CSS will continue to bring about a radical change in the life of the unfortunate women in the future," the mayor said while giving his reaction to reporters after distributing certificates among the 23 women.

### Food poisoning kills 2

Two persons died at Ashrafpur village in Shibganj upazila on Wednesday night allegedly after taking poisonous breads. Officer-In-Charge (OC) at Shibganj police station Zahidul Islam said over cell phone that victims Nazir Uddin, 70, and his daughter-in-law Khadiza, 23, and 13 other family members ate home made breads at night and all of them fell sick. They were taken to Shaheed Ziaur Rahman Medical College Hospital where Nazir and Khadiza died. Hospital sources said that rest of the family members recovered and returned home.

### Outlaw held in Narail

Kalia police on Wednesday night arrested an outlaw and recovered pistol, pipe gun and bullets from his possession. Arrestee Alam alias Anu alias Maruf Hossain, 35, of Chacharpur Naldanga village in Jhenidah district is a regional leader of Janajuddho faction of PBCP. Acting on a tip-off, police raided a tea-shop at Dighla bazar under Narail district and arrested him. Police said Alam is a close aide to top outlaw Dada Tapan who was killed in 'crossfire' with Rab a few months ago in Kushtia.

### BDR chief visits 4 battalions

Director General (DG) of Bangladesh Rifles (BDR) Maj Gen Md Mainul Islam has visited four battalions under Rajshahi sector. He held meetings with officials and soldiers of two battalions in Naogaon on Thursday and two other battalions in Rajshahi and Chapainawabganj yesterday. The BDR chief asked the border guards to come forward to help the on-going legal procedure in the mutiny cases by disclosing the truths. Talking with the press in Rajshahi, Maj Gen Mainul termed the BDR mutiny of February 25 and 26 as a curse. He hoped the paramilitary forces would be free from the curse with the completion of the trial of the mutineers. Replying to a question, the BDR chief said, work on rebuilding the BDR is going on to make it more effective. "Changing the forces' name and uniform are external; we are also considering some internal reforms".

### 4 hurt in Rangamati clash

Four madrasa students were injured in a clash with the Jamaat activists at Al-Amin Senior Madrasa at Banarupa in the town yesterday. The injured are Rezaul Karim Sabuj, Abu Taleb, Abu Bakkar and Mohiuddin. Sources said some Jamaat activists led by Abdullah Al-Mamun, secretary of Pourasabha branch of Jamaat-e-Islami and son of district Ameer SM Shahidullah, equipped with hockey sticks and rods mercilessly beat up the madrasa students as they protested various 'corruptions and irregularities' by the district Ameer. Shahidullah is running two madrasas—Al-Amin Senior Madrasa and Al-Fesani Madrasa. Contacted, the Jamaat Ameer said he was not aware of the incident. He also denied all allegations brought against him.

## 'Sit with Delhi to stop Tipai dam project'

### Sylhet agitators' memo to PM

Tipaimukh Bandh Proirodh Andolan (dam resistance movement) yesterday submitted a memorandum to Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina through the acting deputy commissioner, urging her to immediately sit with Indian government so that it stops implementation of its dam project on Borak river.

The agitators announced a fortnight-long protest programme against the Indian move to build the dam in Manipur state.

In the memo, they said the country's people have raised voice against the Tipaimukh project since it will create disastrous situation in greater Sylhet and Mymensingh.

Besides, the Indian government is going ahead with the gigantic programme without consulting Bangladesh. "It is just violation of international rules and norms," the agitators said.

The protest programme includes view

exchange meetings with different professional groups from July 3 to 15 and processions and rallies on July 16.

Earlier, the forum held a rally with its convener Bedananda Bhattacharya in the chair. City Mayor Badar Uddin Ahmed Kamran, Pro Reza-e-Khondaker of Shahjalal University, city corporation councillor Jamaluddin, Asit Bhattacharya, general secretary of Hindu Bouddha Christian Oikya Parishad Sylhet unit, Ghatak Dalal Nirmul Committee Member-Secretary Nizam Uddin Lashkar Moina, district AL Vice-President Zahir Chowdhury Sufian, Sylhet Press Club Vice-president Al-Azad and Metropolitan Business Council President Faruque Mahmud Chowdhury spoke among others.

The speakers said the people of Indian states of Assam and Manipur should also stage strong protest against the Tipaimukh project as it will cause havoc in that region.

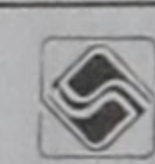
