1. The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received an IDA credit (No. 45055-BD) in the amount of US\$ 62.2 million toward the cost of the Clean Air and Sustainable Environment (CASE) project to be implemented by the Department of Environment (DOE), Dhaka City Corporation (DCC) and Dhaka Transport Coordination Board (DTCB). DOE it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for the provision of consultancy services for the project by hiring an Air Quality Monitoring Technical Consultant (National).

2. The specific objectives of this consultancy are: strengthening DOE capacity on air quality technical programmes including data acquisition and reporting; supporting air dispersion modeling and performing data analysis; conducting several air quality related studies including human health risk assessment (HHRA), pollutants impact assessment etc.; publishing periodic/annual reports and public access to the data via the internet; updating and strengthening DOE Standard Operating Procedures and equipment operation training in the field; developing and implementing a strong quality control/quality assurance programme.

3. The summary terms of reference for the position require the consultant to carry out the following:

- Develop a standard procedure for operation and coordination of Continuous Air Monitoring Stations (CAMS) and Satellite Air Monitoring Stations (SAMS);
- Assist Air Quality Cell (AQC) in establishing the data storage facilities and analyzing data to be generated from the CAMS and SAMS and prepare data summaries;
- Prepare database, daily Air Quality Index (AQI) of different cities and analytical report to permit public retrieval of the data via the Internet and graphical analysis of selected data on-line;
- Develop, maintain and upgrade the comprehensive emission database for all type of emission sources;
- Conduct selective studies like human health risk assessment (hazard identification, exposure assessment, dose-response assessment, risk characterisation & risk communication), emission impact assessment etc.
- Prepare draft TOR for various consultants to be engaged under the environment component of the project and finalise TORs after review/comments from respective technical experts;
- Support PIU in the preparation of EOI, RFPs, bid documents, evaluation of bids, any other relevant activities required from time to time;
- Assist the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) in overseeing activities of consultants to be engaged for undertaking various studies including modeling (dispersion and receptor), emission inventory, permitting etc.;
- Develop capacity of AQC in running dispersion and receptor models and using software for advance forecasting of air quality;
- Conduct field audits of DOE air monitoring facilities to evaluate use of SOPs, Quality Assurance (QA) procedures and quality control of data as well on-job training of DOE air monitoring technicians in these programs;
- Help set up an air pollution monitoring laboratory in the AQC and develop laboratory protocol;
- Assist AQC in reviewing air quality data for periodic/annual reports to be brought out by the PIU;
- Assist in formulating city specific plan with a time line toward abatement of emission from various sources;
- Assist the AQC in updating the Ambient Air Quality (AAQ) standard;
- Provide support to the PIU in organizing consultation meetings, facilitating workshops and seminars and prepare the minutes of the meetings;
- Provide in house training to PIU and AQC staff as well as staffs from other related agencies on relevant aspects of air quality data management;

Key Qualifications

- Should have advanced degree (minimum MSc) in Physical/Environmental science with more than 15 years of experience in the air quality management field;
- Should have good number of publications on air pollution issues in refereed international journals;
- Should have excellent track record in air pollution monitoring and research;
- Hand on experience of air quality monitoring methods as used by DOE in Bangladesh;
- Demonstrated skills in developing publications designed to explain technical data to the public;
- Sound knowledge of receptor/dispersion modeling, emission inventory, air quality monitoring network design and data analysis;
- Ability to evaluate air quality data to determine patterns, trends temporal and spatial relationships;
- Strong computer literacy with command over MS word, excel, power point etc.; and
- Previous experience of similar consultancy in a donor aided project will be an added advantage.

4. This activity will involve initially a 24 man-month contract renewable on a yearly basis during the project period subject to satisfactory performance. The approximate commencement date of the contract will be September 2009. The contract may be terminated, extended or renegotiated before or beyond the stated time period.

5. The consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out by the World Bank's guidelines, "Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers May, 2004 (Revised October, 2006)".

Brief description of assignment and background	Bangladesh Public Service Commission (BPSC) Secretariat has been allocated public funds from Reimbursable Project Aid (RPA), a grant of the IDA towards the cost of the project "Strengthening BPSC's Organizational Structure with Emphasis on its Recruitment Functions." With a view to modernizing overall existing services and functions through establishing an efficient and modernized system, BPSC needs services of a reputed "Survey firm/contractor for conducting survey". This service will aim at integrating the public perception towards civil service recruitment, determining training needs, promotion and disciplinary reviews through transparent processes, better outcomes and enhanced public dissemination. The study requires both qualitative and quantitative research techniques. The study requires the following activities: a) To develop various survey instruments and conduct survey to benchmark public perception about BPSC's overall image including its recruitment and promotional functions. b) To identify understanding of the stakeholders and attitudes regarding BPSC. c) To find out past public perception about BPSC and their main reasons. The study report will suggest the improvement of present images. d) To assess public opinion on recent changes in the quality of services provided by BPSC. e) To help establish a methodology and a set of indicators for future public opinion surveys and research. f) To suggest introduction of a mechanism for regular public feedback to facilitate the promotion of people's participation. The selected firm will first conduct qualitative research (such as focus groups) to assist with development and pre-testing of the questionnaire, methodology and determination of appropriate terminology, then conduct quantitative research to obtain reasonably accurate responses in the survey. The successful firm will be provided the detailed frameworks for conducting the survey from the Project Director (will be available in the TOR). The time frame for the completion of the survey will be approximately 3 months; expected to begin in early September 2009. The Survey firm will be responsible to the Project Director and report directly to him. The firm will liaise closely with the BPSC Task Team and work under guidance of the Lead Consultant (International) of the project.
