

## Lawyers still hope Suu Kyi to be 'freed unconditionally'

Lawyers for Myanmar democracy leader Aung San Suu Kyi said Sunday they still hoped she would be "freed unconditionally", despite widespread fears of a guilty verdict in her prolonged prison trial.

The Nobel peace laureate faces up to five years in jail if convicted on charges of breaching the terms of her house arrest following an incident in which an American man swam across a lake to her heavily-secured villa in May.

The two-and-a-half month trial has provoked international outrage and critics have accused Myanmar's junta of using the intrusion as an excuse to keep her locked up during elections scheduled for 2010.

A verdict had been expected on Friday but judges postponed their pronouncement

until August 11, saying they needed time to review the case. "We hope that she will be freed unconditionally," said Nyan Win, one of Suu Kyi's lawyers and a spokesman for her National League for Democracy (NLD).

"We have nothing much to do. We are just waiting for the next trial date. Tomorrow we will submit an application to the authorities to meet Aung San Suu Kyi and we hope to meet her on Wednesday or Thursday," he told AFP.

He said Suu Kyi, currently detained at Yangon's notorious Insein prison, had instructed her defence team to visit her before August 11.

The delayed verdict, which adds to uncertainty over the junta's plans for the democracy icon, was hailed Friday by her lawyers as a sign that the judges have "serious legal problems".

Ahead of Friday's expected decision, UN chief Ban Ki-moon had pressed for the immediate release of Suu Kyi during a meeting with Myanmar's UN ambassador, a UN spokesman said.

Washington, which like the European Union has imposed sanctions against the Myanmar regime, also demanded Thursday that Suu Kyi and another 2,100 political prisoners in Myanmar should be "immediately and unconditionally released".

Analysts say Myanmar's rulers have showed rare concern for foreign opinion by delaying the verdict, but only because they want to minimise the fallout while pursuing a hard-line against her.

The junta has kept Suu Kyi in detention for a total of nearly 14 years since refusing to recognise the NLD's landslide victory in elections in 1990.

## Khatami terms trial of protesters a sham

An influential pro-reform ex-president criticised the country's first trial of activists and protesters following the disputed presidential election as a sham that would further erode confidence in the ruling Islamic establishment.

Mohammad Khatami said he hoped the "show" trial of more than 100 people that started Saturday would not "lead to ignorance of the real crimes" carried out by authorities following the June 12 vote, including alleged abuse and murder of detainees.

On Sunday 10 more protesters who opposed the re-election of President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad were put on trial in a revolutionary court in Tehran on Sunday, the ISNA news agency reported.

"This morning, 10 other defendants were put on trial in a revolutionary court in a closed session," the report said quoting a judiciary official.

"These people are among those arrested in the incidents after the election."

The opposition has sought to capitalise on growing criticism from both conservatives and reformists of the government's violent crack down against the hundreds of thousands of people who took to the streets following the election to protest hard-line President Mahmoud Ahmadinejad's disputed victory.

At least 20 people were killed in the unrest that followed the vote, although human rights groups believed the number is far greater and at least one person has died while in government detention.

The mass trial is part of the government's efforts to choke off the protest movement by targeting key supporters of Mir Hossein Mousavi, the opposition leader who claims he was the true election winner. The defendants include some of the most prominent reformist politicians, including Khatami's former vice presi-

dent, Mohammad Ali Abtahi.

The government used Saturday's hearing to press its claims that the opposition was a tool of foreign countries seeking to topple the Iranian government.

State media quoted Abtahi and others as confessing to working together to foment unrest. But rights groups have said such confessions are often obtained under duress in Iran.

"Relying on claimed confessions expressed in this specific situation has no credit," said Khatami, according to a report posted on his Web site, Baran, late Saturday.

The former president, who held office from 1997 to 2005, criticised the court for not allowing defendants' lawyers access to the courtroom or the case files.

"As far as I have learned, what happened in the trial was contrary to the constitution and law, as well as citizens' rights," said Khatami.

Instead of a show trial, Khatami said the public expected the government to "confront the problems and tragedies that happened in some detention centres and apparently to murder."

Some conservatives joined the chorus of reformists criticising the government's violent crack down following the death of the son of a prominent member of their camp, Abolmohsen Rouhollahi. Rouhollahi is a close ally of Mohsen Rezaei, the only conservative who ran against Ahmadinejad in the election.

His son, Mohsen, who was arrested during a July 9 protest, was taken to a hospital after two weeks and died. The Norooz Web site reported that Mohsen's face was beaten in when his father received the body.

The growing criticism comes only days before Ahmadinejad is to be sworn into a second term and has compounded the biggest challenge the cleric-led government has faced since the 1979 Islamic revolution.

## Pakistan books Swat cleric for treason

Pakistan police have laid charges of treason, terrorism and rebellion against a radical Islamic cleric who brokered a peace deal with Taliban in the Swat valley, officials said yesterday.

Sufi Mohammad, the father-in-law of Maulana Fazlullah, the leader of the Taliban in Swat and head of a banned Islamist militant group, was arrested on July 26 on the outskirts of Peshawar.

"We have registered a case of treason, rebellion and terrorism against Sufi Mohammad," Swat police chief Sajid Khan Mohmand told AFP by telephone.

He has been charged on the basis of a speech he delivered on April 19, declaring that he does not believe in democracy, the constitution of Pakistan or its judicial and parliamentary system, Mohmand said.

"A case of waging war and conspiracy against the country has also been registered," he said.

Information minister for North West Frontier Province (NWFP) Mian Iftikhar Hussain, earlier said the cleric had killed a lot of people and was planning violence again.

"His actions so far indicate that he still has close ties to the Taliban of Swat," Hussain told AFP last week.

Fazlullah, who has a 50-million-rupee (615,000-dollar) price on his head, is the architect of an uprising that marked the only time that a district under Pakistani government control has effectively slipped into hands of the Taliban.

He has led thousands of supporters, a mixture of hardcore ideologues and disenfranchised young men, in a brutal campaign beheading opponents, burning scores of schools and fighting against government troops since November 2007.

Under a deal brokered by Mohammad, the Pakistani government agreed to allow the implementation of Islamic law in Swat once violence had stopped but Taliban militants led by Fazlullah refused to lay down arms and undermined the deal.

Pakistan troops launched an operation in late April to root out the extremists after Taliban advanced to within 100km of Islamabad. Officials say more than 1,800 militants and 166 security personnel have been killed since then.

any installations or erection work in progress in the area from the chopper.

On Saturday, the delegation returned to New Delhi from the Assam state's capital Guwahati as inclement weather prevented it from flying to the site of the projected dam on the Barak river.

The team also failed to visit the site on Friday amid heavy rainfalls, and returned to Guwahati where they were staying after a meeting with the Indian government in New Delhi earlier in the week.

Failing to reach the site, the delegation chief Razzak said that he might have chosen a wrong time to visit the place.

"We hovered above the site by helicopter, observing the area for around half an hour from above. It is a very inaccessible place that often experience heavy rains," he said while talking to BBC on Saturday.

The 10-member delegation led by Abdur Razzak, also the chairman of parliamentary standing committee on water resources ministry, left Dhaka on July 29 to meet Indian ministers and visit the site of the planned dam over the Barak, which enters into Bangladesh as the Surma and Kushiara rivers.

It also has two experts--BUET professor Monwar Hossain and Sajjad Hossain of the Bangladesh-India Joint Rivers Commission.

The team during its stay in New Delhi held talks with Indian power minister and officials concerned. The Bangladesh team suggested a joint survey of the project by experts from both the countries.

Indian side reportedly assured the Bangladesh team that they would not do anything that could harm the relationship between the two countries. They said the dam was designed to produce hydro-electricity, not for irrigation.

The main opposition BNP and its ally Jamaat-Islami did not join the team despite request from the government side.

## Outlaw killed in 'shootout'

A regional leader and a top cadre of Janajuddho faction of the outlawed Purbo Banglar Communist Party (PBCP-ML) were shot dead in a "shootout" between their cohorts and police at Beel Amla in Mirpur upazilayesterday.

The deceased, Jahangir Alam, 36, and Yarul Islam, 32, were from Khalishakundi in Daulatpur upazila in Kustitia. Jahangir was the regional leader of the outfit.

Acting on a tip-off, separate teams of Daulatpur and Mirpur police swooped on the north side of GK (Ganges-Kabadak) main canal, where a meeting was being held by Jahangir at about 5:00am.

As police reached the place, Janajuddho men opened fire forcing them to retaliate. The gunfight ended when the cadres stopped firing and fled the scene.

Police recovered two dead bodies lying in a pool of blood. Police recovered two pistols and 12 bullets from the spot.

Police said both Jahangir and Yarul were top wanted outlaws in the district.

Jahangir was a convicted criminal. He was awarded 10 years imprisonment in an extortion case two years ago. He was also accused in at least 10 cases including five for murder.

Yarul was accused of several murders in the district with a number of other crimes including extortion and robbery filed with Mirpur and Daulatpur police stations.

They held responsible Faruque for the attack on the Proshika head office Saturday, which left at least 50 officials including some of their female colleagues injured.

They also said that the attackers had ransacked 15 vehicles parked outside the office of Proshika and damaged a portion of a wall. Proshika Chairman Abdul Wadud, Chief Executive Officer Mahbub-Ul-Karim and Micro-credit Director Abdur Rob attended the briefing.

Asked about the legality of the governing board, Wadud said, "The governing board at a meeting removed Faruque on May 24 after a month-long agitation by its employees."

"Eight out of nine members of the governing body attended the meeting held at the Proshika headquarters in Mirpur and unanimously appointed me as its chairman as the founder chief is accused of massive corruption, nepotism and politicisation of the organisation," he said.

Mahbub said they were surprised at the silent role of the law enforcement agencies in the Saturday's attack led by Faruque.

"It was a horrible experience for us that a number of unruly people led by Faruque swooped on us while the law enforcers played the role of

mere spectators," he added. "Had the police played their due role the officials would not have been hurt and properties could have been saved," said the chief executive officer. He felt that some influential quarters fuelled the agitation.

Meanwhile, an uneasy calm gripped Proshika head office yesterday in the city's Mirpur with hundreds of employees guarding the main entrance following Saturday's violent attacks on its employees.

Several hundred male employees passed a sleepless night staying back at the office in apprehension that Proshika's sacked chief Qazi Faruque and his men might take control of the office.

A good number of employees attended the office yesterday but most of them were on guard at the main entrance and the first floor.

Alauddin, a senior accounts coordinator, said that most of the employees turned up but normalcy in the office is yet to return.

Roksana Sultana, a coordinator at finance department, who lives in Gulshan, said she went to the office a bit late at 11:00 am as she was not sure of the overall situation at the office.

"I contacted my colleagues at the office to know the situation," she said adding that she had never been so frightened in her life.

decision was made hurriedly," the law minister added.

Shafique said the president also has the authority to call off his orders, and the government already took an initiative to reverse the decision of sending the two judges into retirement.

Asked if the government will take any action against the judicial officers who demonstrated at Bangladesh Secretariat, the law minister said, "If there is any allegation against any of them, then that should be investigated."

Replying to a query regarding whether the government's reversal of decision will become an embarrassment for it, the law minister said he does not feel so, "since the government detected an error and took steps to remedy it".

Asked whether there was any pressure on the law ministry to send the two judges into retirement, he said there was none.

Prominent lawyer Dr M Zahir welcomed the reversal saying, "The government reversed its decision for the sake of the judiciary. I welcome it."

On July 27, Shafique Ahmed said the Supreme Court (SC) is the authority to take any action against the judicial officials who demonstrated at Bangladesh

Secretariat, as they serve under the SC since the separation of the judiciary from the executive branch of the government.

Sources said the decision of taking actions against the two judges was taken bypassing the law minister, and some powerful persons in the government instigated the law ministry to recommend to the president, through the prime minister, the issuance of the order.

An eight-member delegation of BJSa led by Abdul Gafur and Md Shahjahan met Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina in her official residence Jamuna yesterday morning and demanded reversal of the decision.

The sources said the premier assured the delegation of considering their demand.

The BJSa leaders earlier had taken preparations to file separate writ petitions with the High Court (HC) challenging the legality of the government's decision to send the two into forced retirement, but following the premier's assurance that their demand will be considered, they refrained from filing the writs, an association leader told The Daily Star.

BJSa has been waging a movement demanding removal of Law Secretary Kazi Habibul Awal from his position, saying that he was

illegally accommodated in the ministry, and has been acting against the interest of judicial officials.

A leader of the association recently told The Daily Star that Awal became the law secretary using his clout over the ministry during the immediate past caretaker government following 1/11.

"Awal had come to the drafting wing of law ministry from the judicial cadre during the previous Awami League government. According to the promotion rules-2002, the highest official position in the drafting wing is the post of an additional secretary. But, he was elevated to the post of the law secretary violating the promotion rules, due to his influence in the caretaker government," the BJSa leaders said.

"The High Court declared his appointment illegal on different grounds, but the Supreme Court stayed the High Court verdict. Since then Awal has been repeatedly petitioning for rescheduling the hearing for a settlement of the issue in a bid to keep delaying possible upholding of the verdict," he added.

When The Daily Star tried to contact Awal for comment, his private secretary said the law secretary was not interested in talking to the media.
