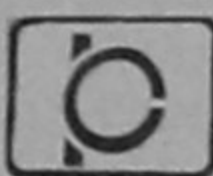

- The People's Republic of Bangladesh has received an IDA credit [No. 4581-BD] in the amount of US\$ 62.2 million toward the cost of the Clean Air and Sustainable Environment (CASE) Project to be implemented party by the Department of Environment (DOE) and it intends to apply part of the proceeds to payments for the provision of consultancy services for the project by hiring a Monitoring and Evaluation Consultant (Individual-local).
- The specific objectives of this consultancy are: i) to assist the Project Coordinator to be anchored at the Ministry of Environment and Forest in monitoring the implementation progress of three agencies viz; DoE, DCC and DTCE, and ii) to update and apprise the Project Coordinator on key activities of the project in a timely manner and iii) to identify implementation problems, evolve suggested measures and trouble-shoot for timely implementation of key activities under the project.
- The summary Terms of Reference (TOR) for the position require the consultant to carry out the following:
  - Assist the Project Coordinator in running day to day operations of the project,

- The candidate must have a post graduate degree in Economics/Statistics/Natural Science.
- At least 10 years of working experience in development projects especially on project processing, implementation, monitoring and evaluation etc.
- Work experience to deal with the World Bank assisted projects preferably in environment sector.
- Candidates having training on project analysis, monitoring & evaluation and finance preferably from abroad will get preference.
- Excellent communication and presentation skills in English.
- Computer skill with particular experience in MS-Word, Excel and power point.
- Strong interpersonal and team building skills.
