

EXPULSION OF 11 ACTIVISTS

SUST paralysed as BCL enforces strike

Classes and examinations at Shahjalal University of Science and Technology (SUST) could not be held yesterday as a faction of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) enforced strike on the campus to press home its five-point demand.

BCL university unit has been divided into two factions--Moloy and Raju factions--over taking control of the campus.

Activists of Moly faction enforced the strike yesterday. They also urged the university authorities to meet the demands by August 15. Otherwise, they threatened to call an indefinite strike on the campus from August 16.

The demands include withdrawal of expulsion orders on 11 of their fellows, punitive action against those who attacked the student messes Tuesday afternoon and recovery of arms from the dormitories.

At least five activists belonging to Moloy and Raju factions were injured during the attack. Both factions blamed each other for

the incident.

Raju led faction filed a case with Kotwali Police Station against 19 of their rival group yesterday. Moloy faction also filed a case against 26 activists of Raju faction.

The university authorities at an emergency meeting on Tuesday night expelled 11 activists of Raju and Moloy factions for attack on student messes. Vice-Chancellor Prof Saleh Uddin Ahmed chaired the meeting.

Campus sources said activists of Moloy faction swooped on Samiul of Raju faction at Nayabazar area near the university campus at around 3:30pm on Tuesday, leaving him seriously injured. He is now undergoing treatment at Sylhet MAG Osmani Medical College Hospital.

As the news spread on the campus, activists belonging to Raju faction rushed to the Nayabazar area and attacked two student messes. They also ransacked five rooms of their rivals.

Proctor and other officials along with the law enforcers rushed to the scene and brought the situation under control.

Housewife sues 16

A case was filed with Assasuni police station Tuesday night against 16 people including Assasuni upazila BNP joint convener and Anulia union parishad (UP) chairman Ruhul Qudus under the Women and Children Repression Preventive Act alleging torture on a pregnant housewife.

Marzina Khatun, wife of Mujibar Rahman of village Ekshara filed the case.

She alleged that the accused attacked their rival villagers in front of a rice mill on July 28 leaving five people including herself and her husband Mujibar Rahman seriously injured.

Soon after the incident, she was taken to Sathkira Sadar hospital where she had an abortion because of shock and injury.

Assault on teacher protested

Students of Kittania Para High School under Sadar upazila yesterday formed a human chain on Nilphamari-Deviganj Road protesting assault on their teacher by goons allegedly led by a former student who was expelled from the school for misconduct. The students stood by the roadside for about an hour carrying banners and festoons. Headmaster of the school Nazrul Islam told newsmen that assistant teacher Bhupoti Bhushon came under attack when he was returning home after school hours on Saturday afternoon. Seriously injured Bhupoti was taken to the union health centre for treatment. The students staged a two-hour road blockade at the same spot earlier on Monday demanding arrest and punishment to the culprits.

Housewife found dead

Police recovered body of a housewife from Golara Badrunnesa Madrasa area under Satoria police station yesterday. Victim Majeda Begum was daughter of Shahjahan Mia of Khudrakhol Guchhagram. Police and Majeda's family sources said Majeda was married to Rafiqul, son of Kala Chan of Charkhanda village over a year ago. Lately, Majeda lived at her father's house at Khudrakhol Guchhagram as she had a feud with her husband. On Tuesday Rafiqul went to see Majeda and came out of the house along with Majeda "for a stroll," but they never returned. Officer-in-charge (OC) of Satoria police station said police recovered the body from the spot and sent it to Manikganj Sadar Hospital Morgue for autopsy. The body bore no mark of torture, he added. Victim's father Shahjahan Mia filed a murder case.

Felling of trees prevented

Police yesterday morning prevented illegal felling of valuable trees in the office compound of the Water Development Board (WDB) executive engineer. WDB section officer (SO) Shashank Kumar Biswas said men of Osman Ali of Kazirpara village under Shaikupa upazila were felling mahogany, teak and other valuable trees from the office premises as WDB executive engineer (EE) Zahurul Islam soiled those without tender. Contacted, the EE said that he had sold the trees for cleaning the office complex. Shaiful Islam Apu, ruling Awami League (AL) lawmaker elected from Jhenidah-2 constituency said he had already asked the administration to take stern action against rules violators. Jhenidah superintendent of police (SP) Rezaul Karim also confirmed the incident.

Ruling party cadres out to grab business, demand toll

Jubo League cadres clashed with rivals for possession of a fish trading centre in Barisal yesterday while Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) men snatched tenders from contractors in Manikganj the day before.

In another incident in Jessore yesterday, ruling party cadres assaulted opposition BNP men allegedly for refusing to pay illegal toll.

In Moulvibazar, a case was filed against 20 people yesterday on charge of snatching tender documents.

Our Barisal correspondent reports: At least 10 people were injured as two rival groups of Jubo League cadres clashed for control of a fish trading centre in Hizla upazila yesterday.

One faction was led by Tawhid Ahmed Shikdar, president of Harinathpur union Jubo League, and the other by Tarek Hossain, its joint secretary.

Police and witnesses said they clashed with lethal weapons at Nacchkathi fish

trading centre in the afternoon.

The injured include activists, fishermen and fish merchants. A shop was ransacked and looted during the incident.

Tawhid claimed that the fish trading centre was legally run by him for long while his opponent Tarek tried to capture it yesterday by attacking and looting. Tarek, however, refuted the allegation and said the centre belonged to the local fish traders.

In Manikganj, leaders and activists of BCL snatched tender papers at the local LGED office when the contractors were going to drop them on Tuesday.

Failing to drop the tender papers, Dayan Khan of Air Engineering Service, who had come from Dhaka to drop the tender papers, filed an FIR with Manikganj Sadar Police Station, reports our correspondent.

According to FIR, BCL activist Anjan and others took Dayan and project manager of their farm to a corner room

and confined them in it. Later they snatched the tender documents and gave them death threat if they try to drop the tender or seek police help.

The contractors also submitted written allegations to the Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) authorities in this regard.

The executive engineer of LGED was not available for his comment.

BCL men recently abducted a contractor from the Manikganj municipal office when he went there to drop tender papers. They also beat him up mercilessly.

A correspondent in Jessore reports: Farazi Motiar Rahman, Abhyanganar unit convener of BNP, Rafiqul Islam, general secretary of Jatiyatabadi Sramik Dal unit, and three others were injured in attacks allegedly by cadres of the ruling Awami League (AL) at Nawapara industrial town yesterday for what they claimed refusing to pay illegal toll.

Locals said a number of ruling party cadres attacked

Rafiq with iron rods near Nawapara High School at around 12:30pm. When Farazi noticed the matter and came to his rescue the terrors also beat him up. The attackers left the spot after injuring Sramik Dal's Rafiqul Islam critically. They also beat up BNP activists Babu, Tuhin and Sumon. Rafiq said the AL men attacked him as he refused to pay the toll demanded by them on Tuesday.

Our Moulvibazar correspondent reports: The executive engineer of the Local Government Engineering Department (LGED) yesterday filed a case against 20 'unknown criminals' for snatching tender documents. Executive Engineer Habibul Aziz told reporters that a gang of about 20 took away papers of a Tk 2-crore work when they were opening the tender box on Tuesday noon.

Amulyo Kumar Chowdhury, OC at Moulvibazar Sadar Police Station, said they are investigating the matter.

Subscribers beat up meter reader

Angry locals yesterday beat up an employee of Power Development Board (PDB) and his 'assistant' for their alleged harassment to people and malpractice in electric-meter reading at Bakolia in the city.

As Sadhan Chandra Nath, a lower division assistant of the Bakolia Power Sales and Distribution Centre under the Chittagong PDB, and his 'meter-reading assistant' Abdus Salam went to Bakolia Chairmanghata at around 12:30pm, people confined and beat them up, sources said.

Later, officials from the concerned PDB office rushed there and rescued them.

Locals alleged that Sadhan and Salam have been harass-

ing the consumers of PDB in the area in different ways for a long time.

They realised Tk 500 to Tk 1000 from a customer in exchange for providing opportunity to use equipment that consume huge power, the subscribers said.

In case of refusal to give money according to their demand, they harass people by showing higher reading of the meters, victims alleged.

When asked, Bakolia Sales and Distribution Centre Executive Engineer Mrinal Kanti Sen said departmental action could not be taken against Sadhan as the locals did not lodge any complaint with the office.

Sadhan's assistant Abdus Salam was not an employee of the PDB, he added.

200 injured, houses damaged as BNP factions clash

At least 200 people were injured in a clash between two factions of BNP Sarail upazila yesterday.

The BNP Sarail unit has been divided into two factions over upazila election held in January this year. One faction is led by upazila unit President Advocate Abdur Rahman while the other by Secretary Anwar Master.

Police and locals said yesterday's clash was a sequel to an attack on Anwar Master by his party rivals on Tuesday night.

Both sides attacked each other at around noon. They used sharp weapons during

the clash, leaving at least 200 from both sides injured.

Ten houses and one educational institution were damaged and some shops looted during the clash that continued for four hours.

Law enforcers from Sarail Police Station and district headquarters rushed to the spot and brought the situation under control. They had to fire nine teargas shell to disperse the clashing groups.

The seriously injured were admitted to Sarail Upazila Health Complex while the rest given first aid at the hospital and other clinics. No one was arrested as of filing of this report at 7:30pm yesterday.

Azizul Haque College principal under fire

A group of students of Bogra Azizul Haque College under the banner of "Amra Muktioddhar Santan" formed a human chain at Shatmatha in the town yesterday demanding removal of the college principal for his alleged involvement in admission and financial irregularities.

They alleged that the college authorities did not maintain quota for the children of the freedom fighters during admission and filled up those seats by other admission seekers in exchange for money.

They also brought charges against the authorities of misappropriating money from different heads including transport, sports, health and library.

When contacted, Principal Prof Sultan Ali denied the allegations, saying that he had provided all facilities for the children of freedom fighters at the college.

Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) college unit also staged demonstrations against the principal in and outside the campus recently.

They also submitted a memorandum to the prime minister (PM) through the deputy commission demanding (DC) removal of the principal and probe into his alleged corruption.

After that, the principal was transferred to Polashbari Government College in Gaibanda, but the ministry concerned cancelled the transfer order a few days ago.
